SUBJECT: **MEMBERSHIP FEE AND SUSTAINING MEMBERSHIP DRIVE**

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines is one of the members of the World Organization of the Scouting Movement. Its primary mission is to help young people to develop values and acquire competencies to become the responsible citizens and capable leaders of the country. Over the years, young people who are members of the scouting movement have consistently develop into leader who are model and true advocates of the Scout Oath and Law.
2. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines by the virtue of the Supreme Court Decision became a Government owned and Controlled Corporation since 2012. Being GOCC, it does not receive any Funding from the Government or the National Budget. Council operation depends mainly on the shares in the membership/registration fee and sustaining membership Drive.
3. Registration. The registration fee for Scouts is fifty pesos (₱50.00), unit leaders is sixty pesos (₱60.00), Institutional Heads, Scouting Coordinators and Unit Committee Members is one hundred pesos (₱100.00). Upon registration, Scout and Scouters are issued their membership certificate cards as proof of their registration.

4. Sustaining Membership Drive. As the council derives shares with the registration fee it collects, the office would like to appeal to all scout officials and heads to support the Council's Annual Sustaining Membership Drive amounting to ten pesos (P10.00) per scout which shall be shared by the Local Council, Sponsoring Institution, District Scouting Committee, and the School Division (SDO) Scouting Committee. The following shall be the sharing of the collected sustaining fees:

50% -	P5.00 – local Council	- For council operation and scouting activities
20% -	P2.00 – Sponsoring Institution	- For scouting related activities
15% -	P1.50 – District Scouting Committee	- For scouting related activities
15% -	P1.50 – Division (BSP Department)	- For scouting related activities
100% -	P10.00	

For secondary school not supervised by district, the following shall be the sharing of the collected sustaining fees:

50% -	P5.00 – Local Council	- For Council operation and scouting activities
25% -	P2.50 – Sponsoring Institution	- For scouting related activities
25% -	P2.50 – Division (BSP Department)	- For Scouting related activities
100% -	P10.00	

5. As policy of the Commission of Audit, all collections shall be received and deposited to the council office and the shares immediately withdrawn and acknowledged by the remitting personnel with the issuance of an official receipt. **STRICTLY NO ISSUANCE OF RECEIPT, NO COLLECTION OF SUSTAINING FEES.** It is mandatorily required that all remitting personnel demand for an official receipt or an acknowledgement receipt.
