September 2024

3. VibeRun: Takbo para sa mga Servant Heroes (Nationwide)
1 September 2024, 4:00 AM

The VibeRun or locally known as the "*color fun run*" will be the kickoff activity of the 124th PCSA that will be conducted on September 1, 2024 (Sunday). CSC ROI shall spearhead this health and wellness activity that will be conducted in three (3) different provinces in the region, to wit:

The proceeds of this event will go to the **Pamanang Lingkod Bayani**, a program that honors government workers who died in the line of duty through the provision of one-time financial assistance plus scholarship opportunities to one of their family members.
