### BRIEF HISTORY

The council was founded on August 1948 and was chartered on December 8, 1949. Our pioneer troop leaders: Fresneda Tugade-Tacazon and Caridad Flotildes were trained by no less than the founder, Mrs. Josefa Llanes Escoda.

The reorganization of the movement after the war paved the way for more troops and trained leaders from Ilocos Sur who were registered with the national headquarters for starters, council activities were largely on training of council officers, members and troop leaders who imparted the scouting spirit to girls in Ilocos Sur. It blossomed into a program that developed not only girls, but also young adults along, physical, emotional, mental, social and moral aspects. It continues to be a wholesome source of learning for the essentials of life.

In January 1968, the headquarters was razed by fire. With the grace of God and the many years of hard work by the Ilocos Sur Council, it was rebuilt in 1978.

The early years of the Ilocos Sur Girl Scouts were marred with financial woes yet volunteerism and the generosity of a community that believed in the essence of scouting enabled the local movement to exist. Soon the provincial Girl Scout headquarters building and lot with an area of 963 square meters were acquired in Vigan from Concepcion Ontanon of Poblacion, Vigan, Ilocos Sur. It was inaugurated on November 15, 1962 on the occasion of the council biennial convention.

A milestone during the presidency of former Gov. Carmeling P. Crisologo, was the acquisition of a one-hectare property in Banaoang, Bantay, Ilocos Sur, now the campsite. This was donated by the late Vice Mayor Jose Tongson of Vigan. Consequently, the council bought the adjacent six hectares from the Tongson Family to expand the campsite.

In September 2017, the council headed by Dr. Estrella O. Soria, started the major renovation of the headquarters completed in December 2023 during the term of former Vigan Mayor Eva Marie Singson-Medina, the building has a larger function hall, more spacious kitchen, additional toilets and shower rooms, a board room, rentable spaces and accommodation facilities.

From the era of the morning glory and gardenia troops to the periods of enormous challenges and struggles including the war and the COVID pandemic, up to the gains in the present, the Girl Scouts of Ilocos Sur continue to flourish placing above all the fulfillment of its aspiration to be a channel in molding young Ilocanas to become exemplary women in their communities.

  - A brief rationale for the design.
  - A description of the elements used in the logo and what they represent.

## GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Open to all GSP Troop Leaders, District Field Advisers, and Trainers of the GSP Ilocos Sur Council. Candidates must have been registered with the Girl Scouts of the Philippines Ilocos Sur Council for at least **five (5) years from 2019 to 2024**. All guidelines indicated in each category should be covered in the **triennium 2021-2024**. See the guidelines for each category below.
- **All logbooks and pertinent documents, including photos and/or videos** of the candidates, must be submitted to the Girl Scouts of the Philippines Ilocos Sur Council as proof of compliance with each indicated guideline on or before October 15, 2024.
- There shall be a **document screening** of all candidates that will determine the **three (3) finalists per category**. After which, a **face-to-face interview** will be conducted by the members of the board of judges at the **GSP Boardroom, GSP Headquarters, Vigan City, on October 19, 2024**.

## OUTSTANDING TROOP LEADER:

1. Thirty percent (30%) of the girls in her troop should have remained in the troop for three (3) consecutive years.
2. At least thirty (30) girls in her troop should have earned badges annually for three (3) years through the Eight-Point Challenge Program and in alignment with the GSP's current program thrust.

3. The candidate should have conducted a troop camp at least once a year.
4. The candidate should have organized and maintained complete troop records, including reports, photos, and video documentation.
5. The candidate should have encouraged her girls to secure complete uniforms and paraphernalia from the National Equipment Service or its accredited outlets.

### **OUTSTANDING DISTRICT FIELD ADVISER**

1. The candidate should have facilitated the organization and registration of troops in the district and the remittance of membership fees to the council.
2. The candidate should have assisted in organizing and registering the district committee and barangay GS committees.
3. The candidate should have submitted monthly reports on troop accomplishments, visits made, and other reports required by the council.
4. The candidate should have monitored troop meetings and activities to ensure that the GS program is implemented effectively in the district.
5. The candidate should have ensured that the district committee met regularly and functioned effectively.
6. The candidate should have supported the council in training troop leaders within the district.
7. The candidate should have attended monthly meetings of district field advisers and other meetings required by the council.
8. The candidate should have supported the council in its projects.

### OUTSTANDING TRAINER (OT):

1. The candidate should exemplify the ideals of the Movement as embodied in the GSP Promise and Law.
2. The candidate should have designed and conducted training courses for troop leaders, those working with troop leaders, girl scouts and those in administration within the triennium.
3. The candidate should have conducted training courses or sessions at the regional and/or national level.
4. The candidate should understand the support function of training, as demonstrated by carefully planned sessions.
5. The candidate should have guided a prospective trainer through the certification process within the triennium.
6. The candidate should have attended the meetings for annual trainers' updates (whether via Zoom or face-to-face) at any level during the triennium.
