CRITERIA FOR JUDGING - BEST RESEARCH POSTER

1. **Content and Relevance (30%)**
 - The poster effectively communicates the key elements of the research (problem, objectives, methodology, findings, and conclusions).
 - The content aligns with the congress theme, "Transforming Education Through Research."
 - The research presented addresses significant educational issues or contributes to innovative practices.
2. **Visual Appeal and Design (25%)**
 - The poster has a clear and logical layout, making it easy to follow.
 - Visual elements (charts, graphs, images) are used effectively to enhance understanding.
 - The design is aesthetically pleasing, with appropriate font sizes, colors, and spacing.
3. **Clarity and Conciseness (20%)**
 - The information presented is concise, avoiding unnecessary jargon or overly complex language.
 - Key points are highlighted and easily understood by the audience at a glance.
 - The poster is free of typographical and grammatical errors.
4. **Originality and Creativity (15%)**
 - The poster demonstrates creativity in presenting the research in an engaging way.
 - Unique or innovative approaches are taken in the design and content to make the poster stand out.
5. **Engagement and Presentation (10%)**
 - The researcher effectively explains the content during poster presentations.
 - The presenter engages with viewers, answers questions confidently, and demonstrates deep knowledge of the research.
