

All high schools with active units are encouraged to send at least three (3) participants. The Council is encourages female participation.

Registration fee: A registration fee of eight hundred fifty pesos (P850.00) shall be charged to each participant to defray expenses for the food (2 breakfasts, (2) lunches, (2) dinner, and (4) snacks), forum materials, and other administrative cost.

Thing to Bring: Participants are be advise to bring their tents, sleeping gear, smart casual clothes, complete and proper Type A Uniform (polo, and long pants) red neckerchief, and carabao slide (which will worn at the forum at all times) and other personal belongings. Each participant's school/unit must have one (1) laptop for encoding and preparation purposed.
