excellence and become active players in the school and the community.

SECTION 3. COVERAGE. This Ordinance shall cover all senior high school students who are enrolled in public high schools in the City of Vigan.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following terms shall be used:

- a. **Learners** - This refers to senior high school students currently enrolled in grade level 12.
- b. **"Young Bigueño City Scholar" Award** - This refers to the academic excellence award given at the end of the school year, to graduating grade 12 learners, who are within the top three (3) in academic standing and have attained a general average of at least 90 and a passing final grade in all learning areas; and
- c. **"Young Bigueño Public Service" Award** - This refers to the special award given to graduating grade 12 learners who have shown exemplary leadership and invaluable commitment to the service of the school, the community and the student body, in accordance with DepEd Order No. 36, series of 2016 and/or as determined by the Local School Board.

SECTION 4. INCENTIVE CLAUSE

- a. **"Young Bigueño City Scholar" Award for Grade 12 Top Three (3) Academic Awardees** - The learners who are distinguished with highest honors, as endorsed by the DepEd, shall each be given a mayor's academic excellence medal, certificate and the following cash incentives:


- b. **For "Young Bigueño Public Service" Awardees** - Distinguished Grade 12 Graduating Student/s who have demonstrated the value of public service above self by showing exemplary leadership and invaluable commitment to the service of the school, the community and the student body, shall each be granted a mayor's public service medal, certificate and cash incentive of PhP2,000.00.

The amount of cash incentives to be given may increase and be determined by the Local School Board and must be





certified available by the City Budget Officer, should it be necessary and if budget so permits, taking into consideration that the same should be given in incremental amount from First General Highest Average, and so forth.

SECTION 5. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES. The Local School Board shall be the main implementer of this Ordinance and shall formulate the implementing guidelines, passed through a board resolution.

SECTION 6. FUNDING/APPROPRIATION. To implement the provisions of the ordinance, the budgetary requirements shall be appropriated under the annual General Fund of the City.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any ordinance rules and regulations and executive issuances found inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain valid and legal.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and availability of funds.

EXCERPTS FROM THE MINUTES OF THE 65TH REGULAR SESSION OF THE 11TH SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF ILOCOS SUR HELD VIA e-SESSION, ON FEBRUARY 6, 2024

PROVINCIAL RESOLUTION NO. 1550CMS
Series of 2024

A RESOLUTION APPROVING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 43, S.2023 OF VIGAN CITY, ILOCOS SUR, INSTITUTIONALIZING THE RECOGNITION OF ACADEMIC ACHIEVER AND PUBLIC SERVICE AWARDS FOR VIGAN CITY PUBLIC SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL LEARNERS, PROVIDING FOR GRANT OF INCENTIVES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 468(1)(i) of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan has the power to review all ordinances approved by the Sanggunians of component cities and municipalities;

WHEREAS, Section 56(c) of the same Act provides that if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds that such an ordinance or resolution is beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned, it shall declare such ordinance or resolution invalid in whole or in part;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 43, S.2023 of Vigan City, Ilocos Sur, institutionalizing the recognition of academic achiever and public service awards for Vigan City Public Senior High School learners, providing for grant of incentives and appropriating funds thereof, is not contrary to any existing laws, rules and regulations and the enactment of the ordinance is within the powers, duties and functions of the said LGU;

NOW THEREFORE, the 11th Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Ilocos Sur, in session assembled, on motion of Hon. Jaime M. Singson, UNANIMOUSLY SECONDED, RESOLVED, as it is HEREBY RESOLVED, to approve City Ordinance No. 43, S.2023 of Vigan City, Ilocos Sur, institutionalizing the recognition of academic achiever and public service awards for Vigan City Public Senior High School learners, providing for grant of incentives and appropriating funds thereof.
