1. Under Republic Act 10588, also known as the "Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013," it is the State's policy to support programs that enhance and promote the Palarong Pambansa as the primary means of providing in-school sports opportunities to improve the physical, intellectual, and social well-being of the youth. Also, in preparation to the conduct of school and division sports competition for SY 2025-2026, this office announces the conduct of the Gymnastics talent identification on April 11, 2025 at Vigan Central School (8:00 am – 12:00nn) for western schools while eastern schools will be held at Nagsangalan Elementary School (1:00 pm -5:00 pm)
2. The activity aims to:
 1. To identify key traits using various methods, including physical tests and skill assessments, to evaluate factors like strength, flexibility, coordination, agility, and power, which are crucial for gymnastics performance;
 2. To enhance the competence level of student-athletes in their respective events; and
 3. To develop of specific training programs tailored to the identified talents, aiming to optimize their potential and prepare them for competitive gymnastics.
3. All schools are enjoined to send participants to this sports program. Participants to this training are interested athletes for the following gymnastics disciplines;

NO.	GYMNASTICS DISCIPLINE
1.	Women's Artistic Gymnastics
2.	Men's Artistic Gymnastics
3.	Rhythmic Gymnastics
4.	Aero Gymnastics

4. Parent's permit of athletes must be secured by the participating athletes before the conduct of the talent identification.



5. In strict compliance with DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 also known as the Child Protection Policy, designated chaperone from the athlete's school shall accompany their athletes in going to the playing venue for the safety and security of the athletes.
6. Athletes and chaperones are advised to wear comfortable clothes and to bring water tumblers during the activity.
