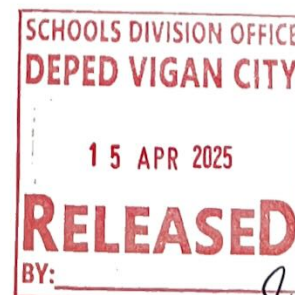

I am writing on behalf of the Philippine Elementary School Principals Association [PESPA] Officers to respectfully signify our intention to conduct the 42nd Principals Training and Development Program Cum National Board Conference [PTDP-NBC] with the theme: "Innovative Pedagogies and Technologies in 21st Century Education: A breakthrough in MATATAG Curriculum" from April 23-25, 2025 at IEC Convention Center, Cebu, Pope John Paul II, Avenue 23, Minore Park Cor, Cardinal Rosales Ave, Cebu City.

2. The Conference aims to:
- strengthen research and innovation for school heads;
 - improve teaching competencies through innovation in giving support;
 - initiate in crafting technical assistance tool for coaching and mentoring; and

Likewise, transportation, accommodation and other incidental expenses relative to the training can also be charged against Special Education Fund (SEF) in municipalities, cities and provinces or MOOE/local funds upon approval of their respective chairman/co-chairman or Schools Division Superintendents subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Arrival and registration of participants will be on April 23, 2025 (Day 1). The first meal to be served will be pm snacks on Day 1 and lunch on the last day of the Conference.
