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# VRO Training the Trainers (VROTTT) Training Design

### I. Course Description:

This course is designed to cultivate ethical and transformational leaders with strong values who will commit themselves to the pursuit of transformation as Values Restoration Officers, values champions, or values advocates. The course integrates transformational leadership, skills development, and values enhancement, to equip the participants with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes needed to transform their respective agencies/offices into values-based organizations. This course aligns with the Values Restoration Program (VRP), which takes a soft approach to anti-corruption initiatives.

### II. Performance and Learning Objectives:

### **Performance Objectives**

By the end of the 3-day training, participants will be able to apply the concepts and skills in Values Advocacy and formulate a plan to champion values-based organization in public service.

### Learning Objectives

By the end of the training, the participants shall be able to:

 Explain the goals and importance of Values Restoration Program or values-anchored programs in developing values-based organization that contributes in nation-building;


- Identify relevant strategies to embody the values of a Values Restoration Officer, values champion, or values advocate in order to effectively lead and advocate for transformation through values in public service;
