**DISSEMINATION OF THE EIGHTH CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 33, SERIES OF 2024 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE REVISING ORDINANCE NO. 02, SERIES OF 2013 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE PLASTIC BAGS AND POLYSTYRENE FOAM PACKAGING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VIGAN"**

 All Others Concerned

1. This Division disseminates the Eighth City Council Ordinance No. 33, Series of 2024, otherwise known as "An Ordinance Revising Ordinance No. 02, Series of 2013, otherwise known as the Plastic Bags And Polystyrene Foam Packaging Ordinance Of the City Of Vigan".
2. This Ordinance shall apply to all persons, retail or business establishments, including food establishments and in all events or activities within the jurisdiction of the City of Vigan. There shall be a strict imposition on the use of plastic bags.
3. No person, or any entity serving food, including canteens and food caterers within the City of Vigan shall use polystyrene products (Styrofoam or styrophor) that are used as containers for food, food produce and other products, whether for dine-in or take out.
4. The Vigan City Environment and Natural Resources Office (VCENRO) in coordination with DepEd, private schools, colleges and universities within the jurisdiction of the City of Vigan, the barangays, Sangguniang Kabataan shall initiate and institutionalize programs, events and competitions aimed to encourage the refusal, reuse and recycling of plastics and to discourage the use of single-use plastics.
5. Attached is the abovementioned Ordinance for reference.

"AN ORDINANCE REVISING ORDINANCE NO. 02, SERIES OF 2013 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE, 'PLASTIC BAGS AND POLYSTYRENE FOAM PACKAGING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VIGAN'"

*Explanatory Note*

WHEREAS, Section 6, Article II of the Philippine Constitution provides that "the state shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160 empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to protect the environment and impose appropriate penalties for acts which endanger the environment including such activities which result in pollution and ecological balance;

WHEREAS, the Philippines uses an average of more than 200 million pieces of single-use plastic each day, which is one of the contributing factors to the problem of pollution and waste problem in the country that affects our coastal resources and marine life;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9003 or the National Solid Waste Management Act was enacted in 1999 as one of the country's policies for the implementation of a systematic, comprehensive and ecological solid waste management program that will ensure the protection of public health and environment, set guidelines and targets for solid waste avoidance and through source reduction and waste minimization measures, including composting, recycling, re-use, recovery, green charcoal process, and others'

WHEREAS, even after more than two (2) decades passed since the Solid Waste Management Act was approved, there seemed to be poor implementation across the country. Presently, waste segregation from the source or the household is still a farfetched practice, as well as the incessant use of single-use plastics and sachets, which tremendously contribute to pollution and climate change due to the increase in carbon emissions;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units (LGUs) formulated their own integrated solid waste management policies and programs to implement the provisions of RA 9003,

however, the same was the case, that is not being strictly enforced;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Vigan enacted Ordinance No. 02, Series of 2013 or the Plastic Bags and Polystyrene Foam Packaging Ordinance of the City of Vigan which provided regulations on the use of plastic bags and styrophor packaging by business establishments and vendors alike;

**WHEREAS**, after ten (10) years, there is a need for it to be reassessed and reviewed or amended to achieve the main goal of the ordinance of reducing the plastic wastes generated in the city.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session duly assembled to enact:

**SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as the, "**Plastic Bag Usage Reduction and Regulation Ordinance of Vigan City.**"

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** It is hereby declared the policy of the City of Vigan to ensure the protection of the environment and enhance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature, through the implementation of programs geared towards a sustainable utilization of natural resources, waste reduction plans, programs and practices and the use of reusable products by discouraging disposable plastic products.

**SECTION 3. SCOPE.** This Ordinance shall apply to all persons, retail/business establishments, including food establishments and in all events or activities within the jurisdiction of the City of Vigan.

**SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** The following terms used in this Ordinance shall mean:

- a. **Biodegradable Plastic Bags** – refer to the new type of plastic carry-out bags such as the oxo-biodegradable plastic bags that degrade into fine wettable fragments through oxidation processes and thereafter attain molecular structure suited for biodegradation that results from the action of naturally occurring microorganism. It strictly conforms to the standards set by DOST- ITDI and the Phil. National Standard (PNS) 2092 of the Department of Trade and Industry.
- b. **Single-Use, Carry-Out plastic bags, sando bag** – refers to any bag made from plastic with 0.025 mm

or less, provided by a commercial establishment/vendor to a customer at the point of sale or owned/possessed by a customer for the purpose of containing and transporting/carrying away goods and intended to be used for one time only.


- c. **Business Establishment** - refers to an establishment or a cluster of establishments engaged in commerce or sale of goods or services, including but not limited to market vendors, shopping malls outlets, supermarkets, department stores, groceries, convenience stores, food chains, restaurants, cafes, bars, sari-sari stores and the like.
- d. **Polystyrene Foam (Styrofoam/styrophor)** - a petroleum-based plastic from polystyrene monomer and a light weight material used in all types of products from cups, plates and as food containers or packaging materials;
- e. **Primary packaging materials**- refer to the first layer of packaging of goods containing dry or wet products, snack foods, frozen foods, hardware, etc. It also pertains to the packaging material used by the manufacturer.
- f. **Secondary packaging materials**- refer to those types of packaging materials used to provide support and convenience in handling or carrying goods with primary packaging. It pertains to the packaging materials used by vendors or sellers of goods.
- g. **Relevant Retailers** - refers to establishments located within the geographical limits of the City of Vigan which are commonly and are regularly engaged in retail business and duly registered as one such as shopping malls, supermarkets, department stores, fast food chains, restaurants, drugs stores, pharmacy and wet and dry markets.
- h. **Reusable Bag** - a bag with hands that is specifically designed and manufactured for multiple reuses and is either made of cloth or other machine washable fabric and/or made of durable plastic that is at least 0.5mm thick and/or made of indigenous materials such as buri, rattan, etc.
- i. **Wet market** - generally refer to the store of products that requires refrigeration or freezing to maintain freshness. These include the wet section in public markets, supermarkets, mini marts, restaurants and *carinderias*/eateries.

**SECTION 5. REGULATORY PROVISIONS.** The following regulations shall be strictly imposed on the use of plastic bags:

- a. No person or consumer shall use single-use or carry-out plastic bags, sando bags at the point of sale for the purpose of carrying away goods;
- b. No person or business establishment shall sell single-use or carry-out plastic bags, sando bags at the point of sale for the purpose of carrying away goods;
- c. Relevant retailers shall only provide carry-out plastic bags that contain marking such as "recyclable" and/or drawn with chasing arrows representing the symbol of a recyclable material, with the name of the manufacturer and can still be reused by consumers;
- d. Only biodegradable plastic bags as herein defined shall be allowed as packaging material for their products;
- e. All business establishments engaged in wet goods, unpacked fresh foods, unpacked dry foods (salt, sugar, flour, rice, grains, feed, etc.) and cooked foods, goods in liquid form, restaurants and canteens, registered manufacturers of foods and souvenir items in the city shall be allowed to use plastic bags as primary packaging material only on the grounds of public hygiene provided that, "Double plastic bags" practice is prohibited;
- f. Consumers may bring reusable/recyclable bags for each type of grocery/purchase (i.e. one bag for laundry soap, one separate bag for edible goods) at the checkout or cashier's counter;
- g. No person, or any entity serving food, including canteens and food caterers within the City of Vigan shall use polystyrene products (Styrofoam/styrophor) that are used as containers for food, food produce and other products, whether for dine-in or take out; and
- h. Relevant retailers shall only provide reusable plastic containers for food, food produce and other products.

**SECTION 6. EXEMPTIONS.** The following items and products shall be exempted on the prohibition on the usage of plastic bags, to wit:

- a. Raw meat and its varieties;
- b. Raw Fish, shells and similar varieties;
- c. Liquid products; and
- d. Other items or products that cannot be effectively contained except through the use of plastic bags.

**SECTION 7. INCENTIVES FOR USING REUSABLE BAGS AND/OR REDEMPTION OF USED PLASTIC BAGS.** To mainstream the use of reusable bags as well as encourage the redemption of used plastic bags, stores may formulate





appropriate incentives to consumers, which may include, but not limited to the following:

- a. **Point System Scheme.** For those stores implementing the point system scheme to their regular customers, additional points to those who are using reusable shopping bag and/or redeeming used plastic bags;
- b. **Green Lane.** All stores shall provide special counters or express/priority lanes to be called as green lane to cater to customers using reusable bags. This will also serve as an information and advocacy measure in caring for the environment.
- c. **Free Reusable Bags.** The City Government of Vigan will provide reusable "model bag" for the consumer for a limited period of one (1) month upon the effectivity of this Ordinance. The said free reusable bags shall be placed every section at the Vigan Public Market and VPM Terminal Annex.

**SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES.** Upon effectivity of this Ordinance, the Vigan City Environment and Natural Resources Office (VCENRO), Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO), City Legal Office, Vigan Public Market, the Liga ng mga Barangay are hereby directed to draft and implement the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance. It may also adopt and amend guidelines, rules and regulations to implement this Ordinance.

A task force composed of agencies mentioned above shall be created to ensure that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be strictly monitored and implemented.

**SECTION 9. INFORMATION, EDUCATION AND COMMUNICATION CAMPAIGN.** The Public Relations and Information Office (PRIO), the Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO), Vigan City Environment and Natural Resources Office (VCENRO), Environmental Organizations shall develop and implement an Information, Education and Communication Campaign (IEC).

The VCENRO in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd), private schools, colleges and universities within the jurisdiction of the City of Vigan, the barangays, Sangguniang Kabataan shall initiate and institutionalize programs, events and competitions aimed to encourage the refusal, re-use and recycling of plastics and to discourage the use of single-use plastics.

**SECTION 10. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR).** Within thirty (30) days from the

approval of this Ordinance, the necessary Implementing Rules and Regulations shall be formulated by the implementing agencies concerned for the proper and effective implementation of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 11. PENALTY PROVISIONS.**

- a. Any **business establishment** through its registered owner/operator and/or proprietor that shall violate any of the regulated acts provided in this Ordinance shall be penalized with the following:
  1. **First Offense** - A fine of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00);
  2. **Second Offense** - A fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00);
  3. **Third Offense and succeeding offenses** - One month suspension of business operations.
- b. Any **individual or person** found to have violated this Ordinance shall be penalized for a fine of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) or shall render Community Service for at least three (3) hours.

**SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** In case any provisions of this Ordinance are declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and affect.

**SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations or any part thereof inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

**SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 33, S.2024, OF VIGAN CITY, ILOCOS SUR, REVISING ORDINANCE NO. 02, S.2013 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE, 'PLASTIC BAGS AND POLYSTYRENE FOAM PACKAGING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY'

WHEREAS, Section 468(1)(i) of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan has the power to review all ordinances approved by the Sanggunians of component cities and municipalities;

WHEREAS, Section 56(c) of the same Act provides that if the Sangguniang Panlalawigan finds that such an ordinance or resolution is beyond the power conferred upon the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sangguniang Bayan concerned, it shall declare such ordinance or resolution invalid in whole or in part;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 33, S.2024, of Vigan City, Ilocos Sur, revising Ordinance No. 02, S.2013 otherwise known as the, 'Plastic Bags and Polystyrene Foam Packaging Ordinance of the City,' is not contrary to any existing laws, rules and regulations, and the enactment of the ordinance is within the powers, duties, and functions of the said LGU;
