**CELEBRATION OF THE NATIONAL FLAG DAYS AND  
 CIVIC REVITALIZATION PROGRAM (SEQUEL OF KKK-RI PROJECT)**

**TO:** Public and Private Elementary and Secondary School Heads

1. In observance of Republic Act No. 8491, otherwise known as the Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines, and in support of Regional Memorandum No. 613, s. 2025, the Schools Division of Vigan City enjoins all public and private schools to actively participate in the Commemoration of the National Flag Days from May 28 to June 12, 2025.
2. This year's observance aligns with the **Civic Revitalization Program**, a follow-up initiative to the successful **KKK-RI Project (Kuwentong Kasaysayan at Kultura Tungos sa Kalinangang Rehiyon Uno)**.   - b. Conduct of flag-raising ceremonies, history-themed educational sessions, and activities promoting nationalism and responsible citizenship;
  - c. Encouragement of wearing national colors (blue, red, white, and yellow) with pride and significance; and
  - d. Educational initiatives revisiting the nation's history and the provisions of the Flag and Heraldic Code, especially the country's struggle for independence.

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

**COMMEMORATION OF THE NATIONAL FLAG DAYS AND CIVIC REVITALIZATION PROGRAM ( SEQUEL OF KKK-RI PROJECT )**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. In line with our continued efforts to promote patriotism and civic consciousness, this Office enjoins all Schools Division Offices to actively participate in the Commemoration of the National Flag Days from May 28 to June 12, 2025, as mandated by Republic Act No. 8491, also known as the *Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines*.

2. This year's commemoration will be coupled with the implementation of the Civic Revitalization Program, a follow-up initiative to the KKK-RI (Kuwentong Kasaysayan at Kultura Tungo sa Kalinangang Rehiyon Uno) Project. The program aims to foster greater civic responsibility, national pride, and engagement with historical awareness among citizens.

3. All teaching and non-teaching personnel are encouraged to be involved in the following activities:

A. Display of the Philippine Flag prominently in all offices, schools, and their residences throughout the commemoration period;

B. Conduct of educational activities, such as flag-raising ceremonies, seminars/sessions, and school or community-based discussions on nationalism and good citizenship;

C. Wearing of national colors with pride. Each color of the national flag day stands for a special meaning. Wear blue, white, red, and golden to flaunt your patriotic side; and

D. Revisiting the nation's history and the Heraldic Code of the Philippines especially about its struggle against its colonial oppressors.

4. All Education Program Supervisors in charge of Araling Panlipunan are requested to lead and monitor the conduct of the commemorative activities and likewise submit an accomplishment reports with photos on or before June 13, 2025 thru <https://tinyurl.com/FlagDays-KKKRI-Report>.
