- 3. GMC offers Bachelor of Arts in Buddhist Studies, Bachelor of Performing Arts in Dance, Bachelor of Performing Arts in Theatre, and Bachelor of Science in Exercise and Sports Sciences.
- 4. Each applicant must submit the following requirements:
 - a. SHS Form 138 (w/ at least 85% General Average)
 - b. Parent's Annual Income Tax Return/Certificate of Indigency
 - c. Accomplished Application Form
 - d. Principal's Letter of Recommendation
 - e. Certification of Good Moral Character
 - f. PSA-Authenticated Copy of Birth Certificate
 - g. Chest X-ray Result (not more than one month from submission)
 - h. Three (3) copies of 2x2 latest ID picture

- 6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.



- Grade 12 students who are expected to graduate at the end of the current Academic Year.
- Students who graduated from Grade 12 in the previous Academic Year or earlier and have not graduated from any college course from any higher educational institution.
- Passer of the Philippine Educational Placement Test (PEPT), Alternative Learning System (ALS) or Non-Formal Education Accreditation and Equivalency (NFEA&E) Program following DepEd regulations and therefore certified eligible for admission to college/tertiary level.
- Must have a GWA of at least 85% or its equivalent.


ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

About Guang Ming College OUR FOUNDER

Guang Ming College is the first Philippine college part of the Fo Guang Shan International University Consortium founded by Venerable Master Hsing Yun. Other colleges and universities are located in Taiwan, Hong Kong, Australia, and the U.S.A.

Province, China in 1927 and entered a monastery near Nanjing at age twelve. He was tonsured by Venerable Master Zhi Kai in Qixia Temple, Nanjing, with Dajue Temple in Yixing, Jiangsu, as his ancestral temple. He was fully ordained in 1941, and is the 48th patriarch of the Linchi (Rinzai) Ch'an school in 1949, amid the turbulence of the civil war, he went to Tajwan

In Taiwan, he began fulfilling his long-held vow of promoting Humanistic Buddhism. In 1967, he founded the Fo Guang Shan Monastery in Taiwan. Having never received any form of formal education, it is the most fervent wish of Venerable Master Hsing Yun that all be provided with the opportunity and access he was denied. With his genuine commitment to fostering places of education, he holds true to his pledge to "impart wisdom to self, bequeath a university to society, confer merits to future generations, and bestow accomplishments to the public."

The Fo Guang Shan International University Consortium

Starting in 1991, Venerable Master Hsing Yun established the University of the West in the United States, Fo Guang and Nanhua Universities in Taiwan, and Nan Tien Institute in Australia. On July 17, 2011, the Presidents of these four universities launched the Fo Guang Shan International University Consortium. This set forth Taiwan's first international collaborative system for universities and a milestone for higher education. The Fo Guang Shan International University Consortium includes Fo Guang University (Taiwan), Nanhua University (Taiwan), Tsung Lin University (Taiwan), Nan Tien Institute (Australia), Center for Humanistic Buddhism, Chinese University of Hong Kong; University of the West (USA).

Since its inception, the Fo Guang Shan International University Consortium has initiated numerous teacher and student exchange programs. Furthermore, students are provided opportunities for cross-enrollment, distance-learning, and postgraduate degrees at partner universities.
