- Letter of Intent from the School Head
- List of prospective SPFL learners
- List of SPFL teacher-nominees
- Pictures of available classrooms to be customized as SPFL classrooms (preferably with provision for speech technology)
- Community mapping – This involves identifying the presence of foreign establishments and communities to validate the need for teaching the specific foreign language. This process ensures that learners will be provided with an authentic learning environment where they can interact with native speakers and immerse themselves in other cultures.

List of Requirements for SPFL Teacher-Nominees


1. Indorsement from the Schools Division Office and Regional Office
Criteria in choosing the teacher-nominees:
 - a. Demonstrate a strong interest in learning and teaching the foreign language.
 - b. Show commitment to completing language training, immersion, and teaching SPFL for at least three years.
 - c. Be physically and mentally fit to undergo training and immersion.
 - d. Exhibit a high sense of responsibility, accountability, and passion for language learning to ensure quality foreign language education.
