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




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



In line with the implementation of Republic Act (RA) No. 11650, otherwise known as the *Instituting a Policy of Inclusion and Services for Learners with Disabilities in Support of Inclusive Education Act*, the Second Congressional Commission on Education (EDCOM 2) has partnered with the Department of Education (DepEd) and the research organization IDinsight to conduct a study aimed at generating evidence-based findings to support the policy directions of RA 11650.

As part of this initiative, IDinsight will administer an online survey to Special Needs Education (SNED) teachers and receiving teachers of learners with disabilities in selected schools nationwide. The survey aims to gather data on the experiences and challenges of teachers in identifying learners with disabilities and in the use of Individualized Education Plans (IEPs).

The survey will be conducted from July 07 to 20, 2025, and can be accessed through the link: <https://bit.ly/idi-iesurvey>. Completion of the survey is estimated to take approximately 30 minutes. School heads are advised to ensure that the administration of the survey does not disrupt the conduct of classes.

In this regard, school heads of the identified schools are requested to disseminate the survey link to a maximum of ten (10) teachers, in accordance with the following guidelines:

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1. Five (5) SNED teachers. If the school has fewer than five (5) SNED teachers, the link shall be disseminated to all available SPED teachers; and
2. Five (5) receiving teachers who currently have at least one learner with disability in their class. If there are fewer than five (5) receiving teachers, the link shall be disseminated to all applicable teachers. If there are more than five (5), the school head shall select only up to five (5) receiving teachers in order of their last names alphabetically.

A limited number of schools may also be contacted separately for follow-up qualitative interviews. IDinsight will coordinate directly with these schools, as applicable.
