- 9. Has never been officially admitted at MAAP

- 3. Copy of Diploma, if graduate from Senior High School, or College
- 4. Copy of Certification of Registration or Registration Form, if College Level
- 5. Copy of Certificate of Enrollment that you are currently enrolled in Grade 12, if Senior High School graduating student
- 6. Copy of School ID
- 7. Copy of latest School Report Card with at least has a GPA of 83%
- 8. Payment of non-refundable processing fee of Php 400.00 in cash on the day of the examination.


