SUBJECT: Conduct of Simultaneous School-Based Encampment on October 24–26, 2025

1. The **Boy Scouts of the Philippines – Ilocos Sur Council**, in its unwavering commitment to uphold the values and mission of the Scouting Movement, will lead the **Simultaneous School-Based Encampment on October 24 to 26, 2025**, across all public and private schools within the council's jurisdiction.
2. This council-wide initiative is designed to:
 - Revitalize and strengthen the Scouting spirit at the grassroots level;
 - Provide Scouts with meaningful opportunities to apply their Scouting knowledge, leadership skills, and outdoor competencies;
 - Cultivate in Scouts the core values of leadership, fellowship, environmental stewardship, and responsible citizenship;
 - Support the effective implementation of the **Updated Senior Scout Advancement Scheme** and the **Revised Merit Badge System** as prescribed by the National Office.
3. All institutional Scouting units — elementary and secondary, public and private — are **strongly encouraged** to organize and facilitate their respective school-based encampments within the specified dates. These activities must conform to:
 - The official Scouting guidelines of the BSP,
 - The applicable safety protocols and academic policies of the **Department of Education**, and
 - Local ordinances, especially those pertaining to risk management and emergency preparedness.
4. A **comprehensive post-activity report** must be submitted to the Council Office **on or before November 4, 2025**. The report should include:
 - A brief narrative summary of activities,
 - Attendance sheets,

- o Photographs with captions/highlights, and
 - o Feedback or evaluation from participants and leaders. These documents will be used for **documentation, assessment, and possible recognition of exemplary units.**
5. In view of the nature and educational value of this activity, the Council respectfully **requests that participating public school teachers be granted appropriate service credits, and non-teaching personnel be granted Compensatory Time-Off (CTO), in accordance with DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012.** This shall serve as due recognition of their active involvement and contribution to co-curricular Scouting programs.
