**DIVISION ORIENTATION-WORKSHOP ON THE IMPLEMENTATION  
OF THE ACADEMIC RECOVERY AND ACCESSIBLE LEARNING (ARAL) PROGRAM**

Public School Heads (Elementary & Secondary)  
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1. In accordance with Republic Act No. 12028, otherwise known as the *Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program Act*, DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2025 on the *Implementing Guidelines of the ARAL Program*, and DepEd Memorandum No. 56, s. 2025 on the *Supplemental Guidelines for the Implementation of the ARAL School Readiness and Responsiveness Audit (ASRRA)*, the Schools Division Office shall conduct an Orientation-Workshop on the Division Implementation of the ARAL Program. This initiative, which serves as the umbrella program of the Department of Education for learning recovery, is a strategic response to persistent learning gaps in reading, mathematics, and science among learners from Kindergarten to Grade 10. It aims to institutionalize targeted and structured learning support, particularly for learners who are below the minimum proficiency level.
2. The activity is scheduled on August 5–6, 2025. The specific venue will be announced in a separate memorandum.
3. The orientation-workshop aims to:
  - (a) orient school heads and teachers on the implementation guidelines of the ARAL Program; and
  - (b) determine the readiness and responsiveness of schools in implementing the program using the ARAL School Readiness and Responsiveness Audit (ASRRA) tool.
4. The participants are as follows:

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5. All participants are required to bring their Beginning of School Year (BOSY) assessment data in CRLA, RMA, and Phil-IRI, approved class programs for SY 2025-2026 including laptop and extension cord for use during the workshop sessions.
6. Meals (AM/PM snacks and lunch) for two days shall be charged against the BEC Fund subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Participation in this activity is compulsory. School heads must ensure that designated representatives attend and actively engage in all sessions.
