

PCEP's Agora is the Cultural Education central public space and venue for our partner Higher Education Institutions, DepEd local schools (SPA), LGUs, National Association of Cultural Educators and Scholars (NACES) to showcase their talents, researches, products, local cultural icons, and their people in one creative market place. In our history, AGORA, in ancient Greek cities, is an open space that served as a meeting ground for various activities of their citizens.

NCCA-PCEP's AGORA or the marketplace, shall be the SM North Edsa, where many locals and tourists visited the place for business, recreation, meeting people, socialization, celebrations and shopping personal needs, watching and appreciating contemporary arts & culture happens.

For the (December 6-7, 2025) 2-day activity, NCCA line agencies, education institutions, student-artists and cultural workers will gather to achieve the following:

1. Exhibition of local products, publications, visual arts, and local crafts shall be mounted by partner Agencies and Education Institutions and select cultural groups;
2. Mounting of "Tula at Pagtatanghal" competition showcasing literary works of National Artists by the participating community-based performing artists;
3. "Dularawan 4: Dance-Musical-Drama production" competition by the participating student-artists in private and public schools with SPA showcasing their local cultural icons through a presentation; and
4. Promotion of creative-products and cultural programs by the NCCA-PCEP, Barasoain Kalinangan Foundation, Inc (BKFI), NACES and other partner Institutions.

ACTIVITIES:

A. LAUNCHING OF BOOKS & READING

Launching of new books of PCEP and reading of Mga Kuwentong Supling to be participated by NACES Alumni from Luzon Visayas and Mindanao.

B. ARTS AND CULTURE EXHIBITION:

Mounting of booths at the main hall of the Mall.

Cultural agencies like National Historical Commission, Intramuros Administration, National Archives, Komisyon ng Wikang Filipino, Cultural Center of the Philippines, National Library, National Museum, Education Institutions, LGU's and cultural institutions / groups are encouraged to participate by mounting their own booth at the Mall to exhibit local products such as local crafts, native to the community and popular local intangible arts can be displayed, sell (subject to approval of the mall) and performed.

Universities nationwide shall also be invited to participate in the event. Their publications, information about the courses offered, amenities, activities, uniqueness, school values can be showcased.

C. TULA AT PAGTATANGHAL

Showcase of Literary works of the National Artists through a poetry reading with drama interpretation.

All interested community-based performing artists (amateur or professional) participants should comply with all the needed requirements:

- a. Participation is maximum of 4-5 artists including technical staff;
- b. Literary piece to be selected by participating group must be an original work of a National Artist;
- c. Drama interpretation along with the poetry reading should be limit to theatrical, dance, and related song interpretation
- d. Basic or standards sound system will be provided by the proponent technical staff;
- e. The presentation must not exceed seven (7) minutes, inclusive of intro and outro;
- f. Selected literary piece must be submitted on or before **October 1, 2025** to avoid duplication of the poem to be performed.

The Performance competition is on December 6, 2025 at SM North Edsa. PCEP will give prizes to Top 3- best performers.

Winners will be awarded with the following cash prize:

Grand Winner – Php 15,000.00

1st Runner-Up – Php 10,000.00

2nd Runner-Up – Php 5,000.00

All entries shall be judged according to the set criteria:

- a. Interpretation and Clarity 40%

- b. Intonation, Diction and Poise 30%
- c. Creativity and Delivery 30%

The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and unappealable.

D. DULARAWAN 4: DANCE-MUSICAL-DRAMA PRODUCTION

DULARAWAN 4 is a Dance-Musical-Drama competition **showcasing local cultural icons** in their community.

All interested student-artists in different public and private schools with SPA should comply with all the needed requirements:

- a. Participation is maximum of 8-10 artists including technical staff;
- b. Production must be original and highlights the local cultural icons in the community where participating school is located;
- c. Minimum of two combined art discipline must be presented;
- d. Entry must be minimalist (symbolic representation) set, original piece of the group, and free from copyright issues.
- e. Basic or standards sound system will be provided by the proponent technical staff;
- f. The presentation must not exceed fifteen (15) minutes, inclusive of intro and outro;

The Performance competition is on December 7, 2025 at SM North Edsa. PCEP will give prizes to Top 3- best performers.

Winners will be awarded with the following cash prize:

Grand Winner – Php 20,000.00

1st Runner-Up – Php 15,000.00

2nd Runner-Up – Php 10,000.00

All entries shall be judged according to the set criteria:

- a. Theme and Storytelling 20%
- b. Performance and Acting 20%
- c. Dance Execution and Choreography 20%
- d. Music and Vocal Performance 20%
- e. Production Design 20%

Actual stage performance is slated on December 7, 2025 at SM North Edsa.

Decision of judges is final and cannot be contested in any manner.

Outcomes:

1. Awareness of Philippine cultural icons increased;
2. Continued learning on Philippine arts and culture promoted;

3. Training needs of cultural workers and LGU executives in terms of heritage preservation listed and documented;
4. Instructional materials on cultural heritage education in terms of conservation, preservation, and management developed; and
5. More government officials and employees with enhanced capacities for promoting cultural education in governance.


