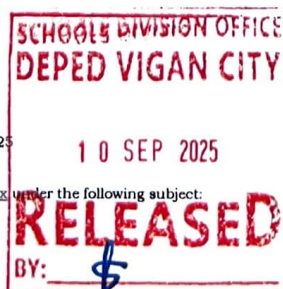

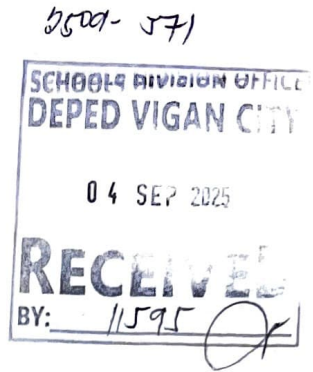

The ACT is a formal teachers' association of ASEAN countries geared towards realizing and fostering the philosophy, concepts, and aims of ASEAN, especially in the field of education and culture. The organization is now more commonly known as the ACT+1 since it has been admitted into the organization, the Korean Federation of Teachers' Associations (KFTA), the only non-ASEAN regular member.
