

In line with GCG Memorandum Circular No. 2023-01 on the Performance Evaluation System (PES) for the GOCC Sector, and as part of our continued efforts to enhance operational efficiency and uphold the highest standards of service delivery, we would like to remind all concerned personnel of the established guidelines for the online submission of community service reports. - 2.0.c. For quarterly submissions, the deadline for each quarter will be every 15th day following the end of the quarter. Submissions received after this cut-off will not be included in the consolidated report for that period.
