Guidelines for the Contest:

- 1. The contest is open to Grade V-VI pupils enrolled in any public or DepEd-accredited private schools of SDO Vigan City.
- 2. The contestants must wear their school uniform throughout the contest.
- 3. The poster must be an original creation of the contestant illustrating the given theme. The theme should be written outside the illustration board's border (1-inch border on all sides), and should not be included in the artwork itself.
- 4. The theme for this year's on-the-Spot Poster Making Contest is "Hand in Hand for Better Foods and a Better Future".
- 5. The contestant shall use the following materials:

20"x30"/1/2 size illustration board with pre-drawn boarders

Oil pastels-24 pcs.

Ruler

Pentel pen

Ball pen

Pencil

Tissue

Cotton balls

Eraser

6. The contest is good for 3 hours and 30 minutes to finish the work.

Visual Impact	20%
Theme relevance	20%



Guidelines for the 2025 World Food Day National and Regional on-the-Spot Poster Making Contests

The Department of Agriculture (DA) together with the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) will once again collaborate in this year's World Food Day (WFD) celebration.

A key highlight of the annual WFD celebration is the **on-the Spot Poster Making Contest**, to be organized in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd). This competition is open to Grade V & VI students enrolled in public and DepEd-accredited private schools nationwide.

The **Regional-level Contests** including NCR will take place from August to September 2025, to be facilitated by the DA-Agriculture and Fisheries Information Division (DA-AFID) and the DA-Regional Offices through their respective Regional Agriculture and Fisheries Information Sections (RAFIS), and in partnership with DepEd.

While, the National-level competition is scheduled on October 15, 2025, in Metro Manila.

Guidelines for the contest

General Provisions

- The contest is open to all Grades V to VI students enrolled in public or DepEdaccredited private school nationwide. Previous national winners are not eligible to participate.
- Contestants must wear their school uniform throughout the contest both in the regional and national levels.
- 3. The poster must be an original creation of the contestant, illustrating the given theme. The theme should be written outside the illustration board's border (1-inch borders on all sides), and should not be included in the artwork itself. Failure to follow these instructions will lead to automatic disqualification.
- 4. The theme for this year's on-the-Spot Poster Making Contest is:
- The Contest Committee will provide all necessary materials for the on-the-Spot Poster Making Contest, as follows:
 - -illustration board (20" x 30"/ 1/2 size) with pre-drawn boarders
 - -oil pastels 24 pcs
 - -ruler
 - -pentel pen
 - -ball pen
 - -pencil
 - -tissue
 - -cotton ball
 - -eraser
- 6. Judging will commence immediately after the allotted time for the contestants. Only the Board of Judges (BOJ), Technical Working Group (TWG) and secretariat are allowed inside the contest area during the evaluation.
- 7. The decision of the **BOJ** is final and irrevocable. However, if a winner is found guilty of any misconduct (i.e. plagiarism, or any form of cheating), the title and the prize will be forfeited.
- 8. All entries shall become the property of the Department of Agriculture (DA) and the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO).

Regional Level

- The On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest will be conducted at the regional levels
 including the DepEd National Capital Region (NCR). (A division/district-level
 contest may also be held, but any expenses incurred shall be covered by the DepEd
 and/or DA regional offices.)
- Each contestant must be accompanied by one (1) coach or one (1) guardian to the venue. However, the coach or guardian is not allowed to enter or move around the contest venue during the competition.
- The regional winners must be formally endorsed by the respective NCR and Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Committees to compete at the national level.
- The national level contestants may be accompanied by one (1) guardian or one
 (1) coach during the National On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest in Metro.
 Manila.

National Level

The National on-the-Spot Poster Making Contest willl be held in Metro Manila.

 The contest preliminaries will begin at 8:00 AM, followed by the contest proper at 8:30 AM. Contestants will have a maximum of three (3) hours and 30 minutes to complete their posters, with the competition ending exactly at 12:00 noon.

2. Originality must be strictly observed. Any form of duplication or copying of artwork

will result in automatic disqualification.

3. The Board of Judges (BOJ) will select the top five (5) posters from all the entries.

 The winning entries will be displayed during the culminating activities of the World Food Day (WFD) Celebration on October 16, 2025, in Quezon City. The best posters will also be awarded on the same day.

5. The National winners will be awarded cash prizes, trophies, and certificates of

recognition during the WFD celebration.

II. Criteria for Judging:

Only the **top five** (5) Posters shall be selected as **National Winners**, based on the following criteria:

a.	Originality	30%	
b.	Creativity	30%
