

#### **GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA**

These Guidelines and Criteria applies to the General Information Category. (Philippine Government & Constitution, History, Religion, Sciences, Mathematics, Phil./World Literature, Music, Visual arts, Current Events, and Ilokano Culture)

- 1. Question shall be prepared solely by the host School (CAS-General Education Curriculum)
- 2. Each school is entitled to send three contestants composing a team who are bona fide students of the school/college/university. One team for the College Level, One team for the Senior High School and another team for Elementary.
- 3. Before a question is read, the contestants must raise their right hand. Each team will be provided with an illustration board, chalk, and eraser.
- 4. The question will be read twice by the Quizmaster. It is only after the Quizmaster shall say "go" that the team be allowed to write the answer. The ten (10) second time limit/countdown will begin simultaneously with the word "go" by the Quizmaster. If a question requires enumeration, the limit will be extended to five (5) more seconds.
- 5. After the time limit, buzzer will sound; the team should stop writing and raise their right hand.
- 6. Misspelled and incomplete answers will not be given credit.
- 7. The proctors will go around and check the answer of the teams.
- 8. The General Information Category has two (2) rounds, Level I and Level II. In level I, fifteen (15) questions will be asked. Each question is worth one (1) point. After the fifteenth question, the Quizmaster will announce the top five (5) teams garnering the highest scores which will advance to level II.
- 9. Should there be a tie for the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) place, both will advance to the next level.
- 10. Another fifteen (15) questions will be asked in the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) round, Level 2. This time, two (2) points will be assigned for each correct answer.
- 11. After the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) question, the three (3) teams getting the highest combined score in level I and level II will be declared champion.
- 12. Should there be a tie, a clincher will be asked by the Quizmaster in order to break the tie, and whoever answers the clincher first correctly becomes the winner.
- 13. The duly registered teacher-coach of the team is the only person authorized to make a protest. All protest should be referred to the board of judges immediately before the Quizmaster read the next question.

# INVITATIONAL QUIZ AND SPELLING BEE COMPETITION October 8, 2025

#### MECHANICS/GUIDELINES FOR SPELLING BEE

- 1. This is an invitational contest open to all public and private schools in three different levels (Elementary, Senior High School, and College) in the province.
- 2. Each team in different levels will be comprised of two (2) members.
- 3. The spelling bee will have three rounds. Easy, Average, and Difficult.
- 4. Each round has ten (10) items but with different score values: one (1) point for each correct answer/item in EASY round; two (2) points in the AVERAGE round; and three (3) points in the DIFFICULT round.
- 5. The contestants must write on their flashcards the word/s asked to be spelled.
- 6. All contestants will be qualified in the average round regardless of their score in easy round. However, contestant/s who will not earn at least 15 points combined in easy and average round will no longer proceed to the difficult round.
- 7. Each word to be spelled will only be repeated once by the Spelling Bee Master. Its definition and etymology will also be given.
- 8. They are given 10 seconds to spell each word in the EASY round; 15 seconds in the AVERAGE round; and 20 seconds in the DIFFICULT round.
- 9. If the Spelling Master says "Times's Up!" and/or "Stop!", the contestants must also stop writing and flash their answers to the organizers and audiences.
- 10. The team who will garner the highest score will be the winner of the spelling bee.
