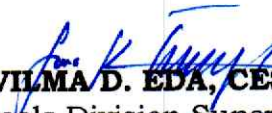

- C. learners (campus journalists and learner-participants).

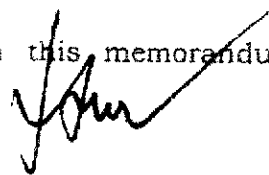
