1. The Department of Education released an **Unnumbered Memorandum dated September 27, 2025** from the Office of the Undersecretary and Chief of Staff Panontongan and Undersecretary Garma, and **Regional Memorandum No. 1321, s. 2025**, both titled "*Social Mobilization Support for ST Nando and STS Opong Relief Efforts*", requesting unaffected regions and schools divisions to extend voluntary assistance to the areas heavily impacted by the recent calamities, particularly through the **Edukahon** initiative.
2. Specifically, **Region I (Ilocos Region)** together with **Region II (Cagayan Valley)** is tasked to provide support to the affected province of **Cagayan**, while other affected areas include **Masbate, Romblon, and Bulacan**.
3. Assistance under Edukahon may include, but is not limited to, the following:
 - a. Cash donations
 - b. Food packs and drinking water
 - c. Hygiene kits, first aid kits, and medicines
 - d. School supplies and learning materials
 - e. Temporary learning equipment (e.g., tents, mats, chairs)
4. For proper consolidation, donations may be sent to the **Schools Division of Vigan City, c/o Ms. Daisy Ancheta, Administrative Officer IV, on or before October 08, 2025**.
5. The support of all SDO personnel, school heads, and stakeholders is highly encouraged to ensure that relief efforts are responsive to the actual needs of affected learners and personnel.
6. Please be reminded, however, that this donation drive is **voluntary in nature**.

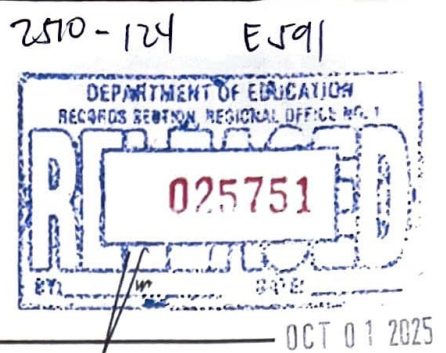

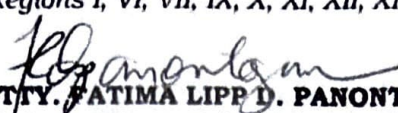


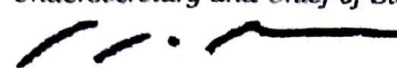

In view of the recent calamities affecting several provinces, unaffected regions are requested to extend assistance, particularly by mobilizing resources under the *Edukahon* initiative, to aid our affected learners and school personnel. For efficiency and proximity, the regions are grouped by quadrant and assigned to provide support to specific provinces, as follows:

- **Masbate** – Regions V (Bicol Region) and VI (Western Visayas)
- **Romblon** – Regions IV-A (CALABARZON) and Region IV-B (MIMAROPA)
- **Cagayan** – Regions I (Ilocos Region) and II (Cagayan Valley)
- **Bulacan** – NCR and Region III (Central Luzon)

Assistance under *EduKahon* may include, but is not limited to:

- Food packs and drinking water
- Hygiene kits, first aid kits, and medicines
- School supplies and learning materials
- Temporary learning equipment (e.g., tents, mats, chairs)

Please coordinate closely with the affected regions to ensure that relief efforts respond to actual needs and avoid duplication. Kindly document all assistance extended and submit updates to the Disaster Risk Reduction Management Service (DRRMS) for consolidation.

Other Regions may also mobilize *EduKahon* relief efforts in coordination with the External Partnerships Service (EPS).
