

For efficiency and proximity, the regions are grouped by quadrant and assigned to provide support to specific provinces, as follows:

- Masbate Regions V (Bicol Region) and VI (Western Visayas)
- Rombion Regions IV-A (CALABARZON) and Region IV-B (MIMAROPA)
- Cagayan Regions I (Ilocos Region) and II (Cagayan Valley)
- Bulacan NCR and Region III (Central Luzon)

Please coordinate closely with the affected regions to ensure that relief efforts respond to actual needs and avoid duplication. Kindly document all assistance extended and submit updates to the Disaster Risk Reduction Management Service (DRRMS) for consolidation.

Other Regions may also mobilize EduKahon relief efforts in coordination with the External Partnerships Service (EPS).
