

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Guidelines for the Children's Literary Cosplay: Children's Wonderland

I. Contest Eligibility & Entry

a. Age Divisions:

To ensure fairness, participants will be judged within the following age groups:

- Group 1 Little Explorers (Ages 4-7)
- o Group 2 Young Adventurers (Ages 8-12)
- b. Costume Source: Costumes must be inspired by a character or element from a children's storybook, poem, folktale popular kid's show.
- c. Registration Requirements:

Participants must register before the deadline and submit:

- Child's full name and age group
- Character name and book title/author
- o A reference picture (book illustration or official artwork)
- d. Parent/Guardian: A parent or guardian must stay with the child throughout the event and during judging.

II. Costume & Prop Safety Rules

To keep everyone safe and comfortable, please observe the following:

- 1. Props must be soft or clearly harmless (foam, cardboard, cloth, etc.).
- 2. Children must be able to walk safely and move without help.
- 3. No messy materials. Liquids, powders, glitters that fall off easily, confetti, or smoke/fire effects are not allowed.
- 4. Costumes must be modest and family-friendly.

III. Judging Criteria (Total: 100 Points)

No.	Criteria	Description	Points
1.	Character Recognition & Literary Relevance	How well the costume represents a character from a children's book or story.	35
2.	Creativity & Effort	Use of materials, handmade details, and originality.	35
3.	Stage Presence	Confidence, enthusiasm, and portrayal of the character during the short walk/pose.	20

- All participants will receive a certificate or ribbon as a token of appreciation.




