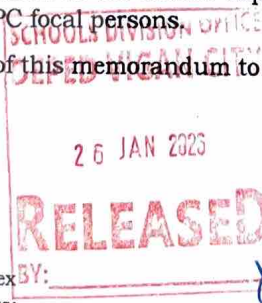

**SY 2025-2026 DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE**

1. Pursuant to the provisions of R.A. 7079, also known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, SDO Vigan City shall conduct the SY 2025-2026 Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) on January 28-30, 2026. This activity will be hosted by Cluster 3, specifically Camangaan Elementary School.
2. The conference aims to:
  - a. exhibit a profound comprehension of journalism by adeptly demonstrating skills across various platforms, encompassing print, broadcast, and online media;
  - b. recognize the role of journalism in advocating for social consciousness and environmental awareness;
  - c. promote the principled and ethical utilization of media, emphasizing these practices as fundamental principles of responsible journalism;
  - d. foster camaraderie and enrich learning experiences through healthy and friendly competitions; and
  - e. provide learners opportunities to use the skills learned in campus journalism for their future careers.
3. Participants to this activity are the school paper advisers, coaches and campus writers from both the elementary and secondary levels of the public, private and laboratory schools of the division.
4. Parent's permit shall be required from campus journalists and all precautionary measures shall be instituted for their safety.
5. The highest degree of honesty and integrity shall be strictly observed in the conference. The school heads, school paper advisers and coaches shall be held responsible for any act of dishonesty, violation or negligence in the implementation of rules and guidelines of the conference. Any form of cheating or dishonesty in all competitions as proven by the board of judges shall be a ground for disqualification.
6. The decision of the board of judges shall be final and irrevocable.
7. School heads are expected to extend their full support and cooperation to ensure a successful conduct of this endeavor.
8. Authority to travel should be secured by all teachers and personnel who will participate in this activity. For personnel in the SDO proper who are involved in this activity, this memorandum shall serve as their locator slip.







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9. The DSPC program of activities, facilitators and committees are enclosed to this memorandum. School heads and teachers concerned are expected to perform their functions to ensure a systematic implementation of the different activities.

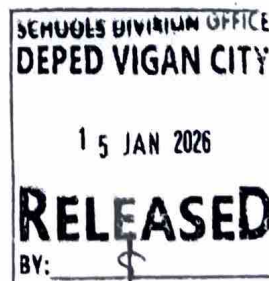
