**REQUEST FOR EXPLANATION ON NON-DISTRIBUTION OF IRON FORTIFIED RICE
FOR THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM**

To: School Head of Rugsuanan-Puroc Elementary School

1. In connection with the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP), all food items must have been distributed last December 19, 2025.
2. Last January 23, 2026, it was discovered that some Iron Fortified Rice packs were not distributed by the school.
3. In view of the above, you are hereby directed to submit a written explanation stating the reasons for the non-distribution of the remaining Iron Fortified Rice.
4. The written explanation letter, duly signed by the School Head, shall be submitted to this Office on or before January 28, 2026.
5. Please be guided that failure to comply with the established SBFP guidelines and timelines may warrant appropriate administrative action, in accordance with existing DepEd rules and regulations.

3. In this connection, this Office requests all Schools Division Offices to recommend five (5) Junior High School (JHS) or Senior High School (SHS) teachers teaching science to participate in the said training on or before February 13, 2026 through the following link.

Activity kits and meals throughout the duration of the activity shall be shouldered by the DOST-SEI, while participants' accommodation, travelling and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds or any available funds subject to usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Corresponding service credits shall be granted to the participants in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 and Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) shall be given to the supervisors/non-teaching personnel as stated in CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004.

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
