POLICY NO. 8-13A

SUBJECT : POLICY ON ISECO LEADERSHIP AWARD

I. RATIONALE

In order to motivate and inspire the future leaders to strive more not only in their studies but in the development of their motivational, planning and organization skills and active participation to the different activities of the school and the community, the coop hereby adopts the policy on Leadership Award that comprises a cash incentive amounting to Php 5,000.00 and a medal for each deserving Senior High School Student who garnered the highest rating but should not fall below 92% of the criteria in the field of Leadership in the Secondary Schools for Public and Private in the Province of Ilocos Sur.

II. OBJECTIVE

The coop is committed to continuously contribute in the sustainable growth of Ilocos Sur thus giving importance to the development of young leaders of the community and recognizing their hard works in their studies.

III. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES

- > This activity shall be achieved through proper coordination with the DepEd Schools Division so that the activity will be participated in by all School Supervisors and Principals.
- > ISECO Leadership Medals shall be distributed thru the ISD-MSD in coordination with the School Principals on the schedule of Schools Awards and Recognition Ceremonies.
- > the awarding process shall be made annually, wherein proper information is conducted during the 1st Quarter of the year.
- > Medals for ISECO Leadership Award to deserving student shall be awarded during the Recognition Ceremonies of the Schools.





> The Php 5,000.00 cash incentive shall be officially awarded to all ISECO Leadership Awardees at ISECO Main Office thru a simple program. They shall be notified on the schedule of the program for socialization purposes to the recipients of the Scholarship Program of the coop and for them to be familiarized with the coop programs.

> There are 114 Secondary Schools for public and private in the Province of Ilocos Sur, hence, there should only be one recipient of the award per school and in the event that there is more than one learner who garnered more than 92% of the criteria, the one who garnered the highest will receive the ISECO Leadership Award.

IV. CRITERIA FOR ISECO LEADERSHIP AWARD:

To qualify for this award, nominees will be judged according to the following:

1. A learner must have no failing grades in any of the learning areas.
2. A learner have not committed any offense punishable by suspension or higher sanction according to the Department's service manual and child protection policies in the current school year.
3. A learner must be a class officer or an active member / officer of any recognized school club, team, or organization.
4. He/ she has served as a good leader to his / her fellows.
5. He / she is disciplined
6. He / she has influenced others to become leader.
7. He /she has good relationship with others.
8. He /she has good manners and right conduct.
9. He / she helped the school in achieving its vision and mission.

Table 3 shows the set of criteria and weighs that will be used by advisers and peers in the evaluation and in the deliberation process. Schools may opt to add more indicators based on the decision of the AC. Candidates will be evaluated by at least 30% of their peers (group, team, class, or club mates) as well as their class or club advisers. Only those learners who garnered the highest rating but should fall below 92% of the criteria shall be awarded.

V. PROCEDURE OF JUDGING:

a) For the ISECO Leadership Award, the teachers shall nominate students who deserve the said award. Upon nomination, the nominees shall be interviewed by the Evaluation Board and shall provide a copy of their profile.

b) The nomination process must be strictly followed. The teachers shall fill up a nomination form issued by the Student Council and Supreme Student government Officers, and shall be submitted on time.

c) The Student Council and Supreme Student Government Officers responsible for compiling all the nominations for verification before the submission to the Evaluation Board.

d) The Evaluation Board shall consist of all faculty members including the principal and the directress.

e) The Evaluation Board shall select the best who deserve the said award. They should not just choose anyone who did not meet the given criteria and failed to submit the requirements.

f) The decision made by the Evaluation Board duly signed and approved is final and irrevocable.
