One of the major highlights of this event is the RSTW RoboTech Cup 2026, which will be held on **February 17-18, 2026**.

The Robotech Cup 2026 is a regionwide robotics competition that aims to highlight the creativity, ingenuity, and technological innovations of Filipino students. Each participating team shall consist of three (3) to five (5) members, with one (1) member designated as the Team Captain. Every team must be guided by at least one (1) mentor or adviser. All team members must belong to the same institution; however, different campuses of the same institution shall be treated as separate entities. Participants must be between ten (10) and twenty-five (25) years old on the day of the competition. Participants who are minors are required to secure written parental consent prior to participation. **The accommodation and transportation expenses shall be shouldered by the participants.**

The competition categories are as follows:

- Search & Rescue - Obstacle navigation and item retrieval
- Bin Collection - Smart robots collecting bins in a city layout

Participation of school heads, teacher-advisers and learners shall be purely **voluntary** and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order No. 012, s. 2025, titled *Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities* and DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*, and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DepEd Order No.66, s. 2017.
