SUBMISSION OF NAMES OF BENEFICIARIES FOR TUPAD IN SUPPORT OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF BRIGADA ESKWELA FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027

All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. The **Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE)**, in partnership with the **Department of Education (DepEd)**, will implement the **Tulong Panghanapbuhay sa Ating Disadvantaged/Displaced Workers (TUPAD)** program in support of the **Brigada Eskwela for School Year 2026-2027**.
2. Under this partnership, DepEd shall identify and endorse qualified beneficiaries for the TUPAD program, a **community-based package of assistance that provides a safety net through temporary wage employment projects** to disadvantaged workers.
3. In this regard, all school heads are requested to **identify and submit ten (10) names of qualified beneficiaries** in each school who may participate in the program and assist in various **Brigada Eskwela activities**, such as school cleaning, minor repairs, landscaping, and maintenance of school facilities in preparation for the opening of classes.
4. The following are the **qualifications** for the TUPAD program:
 - a. **Disadvantaged workers aged 18 years old and above;**
 - b. **Senior citizens**, provided that they are **physically fit to work and will not be assigned to hazardous tasks;**
 - c. **Only one (1) member per family** shall be eligible to avail of the assistance;
 - d. **Not a TUPAD beneficiary this year**, as availment is limited to once annually unless due to calamities.
5. **Ineligible beneficiaries** are government employees regardless of status of employment (permanent, contractual, project-based) including those who are regularly receiving honorarium or allowances (BHW, Tanod).
6. School Heads shall ensure that the identified beneficiaries meet the above qualifications and **submit the list to the Schools Division Office** on or before **April 30, 2026**, at LINK: <https://bit.ly/TUPADBeneficiariesBE2026>.
