The Department of Education – Regional Office I, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), hereby announces the official results of the 2026 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC), conducted from March 10 to 13, 2026, and hosted by the Schools Division Office (SDO) of Batac City.
2. This year’s conference served as a vibrant platform for the region’s finest young journalists, showcasing their exceptional talents, critical thinking, and adherence to the principles of ethical and responsible journalism across both elementary and secondary levels. Relative thereto, the first place winners in both individual and group categories, together with their respective coaches, are directed to attend the NSPC Cliniquing on March 26–28, 2026 at Grand Lourds Hotel, Calasiao, Pangasinan, to be hosted by the Schools Division Office of Pangasinan II. Likewise, the presidents of the Regional Association of School Paper Advisers, both elementary and secondary, are requested to attend the activity.
6. The first meal provision shall be breakfast on March 26, 2026, while the last meal provision shall be lunch on March 28, 2026. On the other hand, the members of the Regional Technical Working Group and the resource persons shall have Day 0 (March 25, 2026) for the judging of the school paper entries.
7. Teaching and related-teaching personnel who shall render services on March 28, 2026 (Saturday) shall be granted service credit and compensatory time-off, respectively, subject to existing CSC and DepEd rules and regulations.
