1. In compliance with Regional Memorandum No. 387, s. 2026, and pursuant to Republic Act No. 7079, otherwise known as the *Campus Journalism Act of 1991*, the Schools Division of Vigan City will participate in the 2026 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) on April 13-17, 2026 in Ormoc City, Leyte, hosted by the Schools Division of Ormoc City, Region VIII.
2. The 2026 NSPC carries the theme: "Mapanuri, Mapanindigan at Mapanagutang Pamamahayag" (*Critical, Principled, and Accountable Journalism*). The activity is conducted to further strengthen responsible campus journalism and to provide elementary and secondary learner-participants with meaningful opportunities to demonstrate and enhance their competencies in print journalism.
3. Participants in the said activity are the top one regional winners in the individual and team events per category and per medium.
4. In view thereof, the official list of Region I delegates to the 2026 NSPC is attached to this Memorandum as an enclosure and shall form an integral part hereof. This list shall serve as the official basis for participation, travel, supervision and coordination, and all other administrative arrangements related to the activity.
5. Further, this Office calls attention to the Office of the Secretary Memorandum dated March 13, 2026, titled "*Directive on Streamlined Delegation and Adherence to Energy Conservation Standards in the Conduct of Significant National and Regional Events*," which was disseminated through Division Memorandum No. 255, s. 2026.
6. All official delegates are expected to arrive at the venue on April 12, 2026. As provided in the national guidelines, the first meal shall be dinner on April 12, 2026 while the last meal shall be the afternoon snack on April 17, 2026.
7. Schools and division offices shall also ensure that the required documents for participation, including the appropriate list of delegates and parental consent, are complete and properly validated.
8. Participation in the conference shall be subject to existing rules on learner welfare, discipline, and safety. Consent of the parents or guardians of learner-participants shall be secured prior to participation. Delegates and coaches are

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likewise advised to take the necessary precautions to safeguard their personal belongings, as the National Technical Working Group shall not be liable for any loss or damage thereto during the duration of the activity.

9. All delegates are further reminded to uphold academic integrity, respect for intellectual property rights, and compliance with contest rules. Any article, script or output found to be plagiarized or improperly generated in violation of the national guidelines shall be subject to disqualification in accordance with the decision of the Board of Judges, which shall be final and irrevocable.

10. Travel and incidental expenses of official delegates shall be charged against the school's maintenance and other operating expenses, local or regional funds, Special Education Fund, school campus journalism fund, or other authorized sources, subject to existing accounting, budgeting and auditing rules and regulations. However, **travel expenses of learner-participants shall be subsidized by the Central Office** and charged against the **2026 Development and Promotion of Campus Journalism (DPCJ) funds**, in accordance with national guidelines. In cases where the downloaded subsidy is **insufficient**, concerned Schools Division Offices and schools may utilize **available local funds or other alternative funding sources**, subject to existing government rules and regulations. Concerned offices shall ensure that only authorized and allowable expenses are incurred.

11. Attached are the official list of delegates of the Schools Division Office of Vigan City to the 2026 NSPC and a copy of Regional Memorandum No. 387 and 410 s. 2026, for reference.

PARTICIPATION IN THE 2026 NATIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

To: Assistant Regional Director
 Schools Division Superintendents
 Chief of the Curriculum and Learning Management Division
 Chief of the Education Support Services Division
 All Other Concerned

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 021, s. 2026, titled "2026 National Schools Press Conference," and consistent with the Department's continuing implementation of Republic Act No. 7079, otherwise known as the *Campus Journalism Act of 1991*, this Office announces the participation of DepEd Region I in the **2026 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC)** to be held on April 13-17, 2026 in Ormoc City, Leyte, hosted by DepEd Region VIII together with the DepEd Division of Ormoc City.

2. The 2026 NSPC carries the theme "Mapanuri, Mapanindigan, at Mapanagutang Pamamahayag" (*Critical, Principled, and Accountable Journalism*). The activity is conducted to further strengthen responsible campus journalism and to provide elementary and secondary learner-participants with meaningful opportunities to demonstrate and enhance their competencies in print journalism, broadcast journalism, and other emerging forms of student media practice.

3. The activity shall include the national contests for the various individual and group categories in both English and Filipino. These include, among others, the individual writing and journalistic contests and the group events in Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting, Collaborative Desktop Publishing, Online Publishing for secondary level, and Television Scriptwriting and Broadcasting for secondary level.

4. In accordance with the national guidelines, the qualifiers to the 2026 NSPC are the following:

- a. For individual categories – the top one regional winner per medium; and
- b. For group categories – one team per medium, composed of seven members, except Online Publishing, which shall have five members.

5. In view thereof, the official list of Region I delegates to the 2026 NSPC is attached to this Memorandum as an enclosure and shall form an integral part hereof. Said list shall serve as the official basis for participation, travel, supervision, coordination, and other administrative arrangements related to the activity.



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All Schools Division Offices and concerned schools are directed to ensure that **only those appearing in the approved official list of delegates shall be endorsed and allowed to participate as members of the Region I delegation.**

7. Further, this Office calls attention to the Office of the Secretary Memorandum dated March 13, 2026, titled "Directive on Streamlined Delegation and Adherence to Energy Conservation Standards on the Conduct of Significant National and Regional Events." In line with Memorandum Circular No. 114 of the Office of the President and the government's policy on energy conservation, fiscal prudence, and responsible resource management, all field offices are strongly enjoined to maintain a lean and strictly need-based delegation.

8. Thus, **only essential participants whose presence is directly necessary for the conduct of the event and the welfare, safety, supervision, and management of learner-participants shall form part of the official regional delegation.**

9. For emphasis, the inclusion of observers, guests, ceremonial companions, non-essential personnel, and other persons without direct and necessary functions in relation to the event is strongly discouraged and shall not be charged to government funds nor considered part of the official delegation.

10. Likewise, side events and other ancillary activities not directly related to the core competitions of the NSPC shall no longer be undertaken, and expenditures solely related thereto, including decorations, non-essential materials, additional uniforms, awards, and similar items, shall likewise be discontinued, consistent with the aforesaid directive.

11. All official delegates are expected to arrive at the venue on April 12, 2026. As provided in the national guidelines, the first meal shall be **dinner on April 12, 2026**, while the last meal shall be the **afternoon snack on April 17, 2026.**

12. For TV Scriptwriting and Broadcasting contestants, as well as Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting contestants, an orientation shall be conducted on April 12, 2026.

13. All concerned are reminded that learner-participants at the elementary and secondary levels for School Year 2025–2026 may participate in only one event, whether under the individual or group category, in accordance with the national rules.

14. Schools and division offices shall also ensure that the required documents for participation, including the appropriate list of delegates and **parental consent**, are complete and properly validated.

15. Participation in the conference shall be subject to existing rules on learner welfare, discipline, and safety. Consent of the parents or guardians of learner-participants shall be secured prior to participation. Delegates and coaches are likewise advised to take the necessary precautions to safeguard their personal belongings, as the National Technical Working Group shall not be liable for any loss or damage thereto during the duration of the activity.

16. All delegates are further reminded to uphold academic integrity, respect for intellectual property rights, and compliance with contest rules. Any article, script,



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output found to be plagiarized or improperly generated in violation of the national guidelines shall be subject to disqualification in accordance with the decision of the Board of Judges, which shall be final and irrevocable.

17. Travel and incidental expenses of official delegates shall be charged against the school's maintenance and other operating expenses, local or regional funds, Special Education Fund, school campus journalism fund, or other authorized sources, subject to existing accounting, budgeting, and auditing rules and regulations. However, **travel expenses of learner-participants shall be subsidized by the Central Office** and charged against the **2026 Development and Promotion of Campus Journalism (DPCJ) funds**, in accordance with national guidelines. In cases where the downloaded subsidy is **insufficient**, concerned Schools Division Offices and schools may utilize **available local funds or other alternative funding sources**, subject to existing government rules and regulations. Concerned offices shall ensure that only authorized and allowable expenses are incurred.

18. The Schools Division Superintendents, through their respective division journalism coordinators and school heads, shall ensure that all official delegates from their divisions are properly informed of the contents of this Memorandum, adequately prepared for the conduct of the conference, and strictly compliant with the limitations on delegation composition and expenditures.

19. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

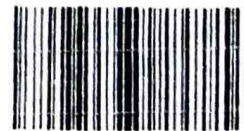
