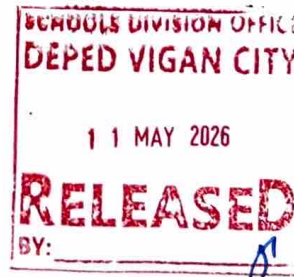

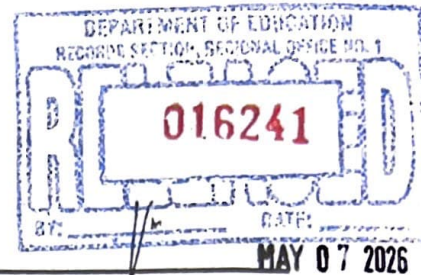

Expenses incurred in the conduct of the activity, such as meals and snacks, hall rental, sound system, and board and lodging of the Technical Working Group (TWG), shall be charged against the Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) Fund under AC-26-5611-BEC-2-P006, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Travel expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds, subject to the availability thereof and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

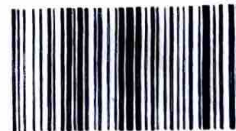
