- c. Letter of nomination signed by the Schools Division Superintendent addressed to the **ESTELA P. LEON-CARIÑO, EdD, CESO III**, Regional Director, DepEd Regional Office I.
- d. Accomplished Matrix (see Annex B of DM OUHRODI-2026-1366). Training certificates need not submitted).

5. All nominations must be submitted to hrdd.region1@deped.gov.ph on or before May 25, 2026, 5:00 pm. **The Regional Office I shall select one (1) official regional nominee** for submission to Central Office on or before May 31, 2026.
