CALL FOR E-LEARNING COURSES FOR DEPED EDUCATORS – 2026 INTAKE 1

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
 Chief Education Supervisors
 Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
 All Others Concerned

1. In reference to Regional Memorandum No. 712, s. 2026, this Division disseminates the “Call for E-Learning Courses for DepEd Educators – 2026 Intake 1” for school heads and teachers.
2. This scholarship program is open to DepEd school heads and teachers with a 2025 Individual Performance Commitment and Review Form (IPCRF) rating. Priority is given to educators with at least 2 years of service. Selection shall be guided by IPCRF performance results, with consideration given to the following groups:
 - a) Teachers I-III requiring intervention
 - b) Master Teachers I-III requiring intervention
 - c) High-performing Teachers I-III
 - d) Head Teachers seeking reclassification to the teaching career track
 - e) School Heads
3. All schools are encouraged to recommend teachers and school heads on or before June 23, 2026, at the link: <https://tinyurl.com/SDOViganELearning>. This recommendation list shall be utilized for the selection and enrollment of 11 scholars by the Schools Division Superintendent.
4. For the selected teachers, school heads are encouraged to put in place appropriate arrangements to support them in completing their LinkedIn E-learning courses.
5. School heads shall allow teacher-scholars to use a portion of the two (2) hours allocated daily for ancillary tasks to engage in e-learning, whether within or outside the school premises. However, time spent for this purpose shall not exceed 2 hours per week. Teacher-scholars will not be required to submit documentary evidence or accomplishment reports for time spent outside the school premises.
6. All provisions under DepEd Order No. 005, s. 2024, Rationalization of Teachers’ Workload in Public Schools and Payment of Teaching Overload and DepEd Memorandum No. 053, s. 2024, Implementation Guidelines for DO No. 005, shall be strictly observed.
7. The No Disruption of Classes Policy shall likewise be strictly observed at all times.

**CALL FOR E-LEARNING COURSES FOR DEPED EDUCATORS – 2026
 INTAKE 1**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Relative to DM-OULS-2026-201 dated May 25, 2026 titled “Call for E-Learning Courses for DepEd Educators – 2026 Intake 1,” this Office informs the field of the E-Learning Courses Scholarship Program for school heads and teachers.

2. This program is open to DepEd teachers and school heads with a 2025 Individual Performance Commitment and Review Form (IPCRF) rating. Priority shall be given to educators with at least two (2) years of service. Selection shall be guided by IPCRF performance results, with consideration given to the following groups:

- a. Teachers I–III requiring intervention
 - b. Master Teachers I–III requiring intervention
 - c. High-performing Teachers I–III
 - d. Head Teachers seeking reclassification to the teaching career track
 - e. School Heads
3. The following process shall be observed:
- a. Interested DepEd teachers shall register using their official DepEd email addresses through the respective Regional Link indicated in. Only official DepEd email accounts shall be accepted. Registration is free of charge.
 - b. Upon successful registration, an official email invitation to activate from LinkedIn E-Learning shall be sent to the participants’ registered DepEd email addresses. Subsequently, DepEd shall issue the required Learning Path to be completed by the participants.
 - c. The LinkedIn E-Learning activation link to be received is unique, individualized, and strictly non-transferable. It shall direct participants to the official LinkedIn E-Learning platform. Upon successful activation, each participant will be granted a three (3)-month license, providing access to flexible, self-paced courses available on the platform.
 - d. Participants shall submit a duly accomplished and signed **Undertaking** (Enclosure) to the SDO Scholarship Secretariat within ten (10) days from activation of their LinkedIn Learning account. The SDO Scholarship Secretariat shall consolidate all submissions and transmit these to the LinkedIn E-Learning Focal, who shall, in turn, forward the consolidated documents to the NEAP Scholarship Secretariat.
 - e. Participants shall prioritize to complete all courses in their assigned, non-negotiable Learning Path. Upon completion, they will receive email instructions from DepEd to access the DepEd-NEAP Learning Management



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System, where they must take and pass the assessment to generate the official NEAP Certificate of Participation. The certificate may be used for application for crediting of Continuing Professional Development (CPD) units, subject to Professional Regulation Commission guidelines on self-directed learning.

- f. Participants are strongly advised to access only the official LinkedIn E-Learning platform and to avoid unofficial pages or sources that circulate similar announcements or links, in order to prevent phishing attempts and potential cybersecurity risks.

4. Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are hereby allocated the corresponding number of participant slots for the program, as reflected in the table below. Furthermore, teachers under the 2025 Intake 2 who received invitations but were unable to activate their accounts, or whose invitations have expired, remain eligible to register for 2026 Intake 1.

5. SDOs through SGOD HRDS SEPS/EPS II shall submit the endorsed list of participants to neap.region1@deped.gov.ph on or before June 30, 2026.

6. SGOD HRDS SEPS/EPS II shall ensure the submission of the signed Undertaking (Enclosure 1) via Google link: <https://tinyurl.com/R1-2026Intake1> within ten (10) days from activation of the participant's LinkedIn Learning account.

7. School Heads are encouraged to put in place appropriate arrangements to support identified teacher-scholars in completing their LinkedIn E-learning courses. This may include providing access to necessary resources and recognizing participation as part of their ancillary tasks.

8. School Heads shall allow teacher-scholars to use a portion of the two (2) hours allocated daily for ancillary tasks to engage in e-learning, whether within or outside the school premises. However, time spent for this purpose shall not exceed two (2) hours per week. Teacher-scholars will not be required to submit documentary evidence or accomplishment reports for time spent outside the school premises.

9. All provisions under DepEd Order No. 005, s. 2024, Rationalization of Teachers' Workload in Public Schools and Payment of Teaching Overload, and DepEd Memorandum No. 053, s. 2024, Implementation Guidelines for DO No. 005, shall be strictly observed.
