2027 Princess Maha Chakri Award (PMCA): Extension of Submission of Nominations

In reference to Memorandum DM-OUHRODI-2026-1366, *Call for Nominations for the 2027 Princess Maha Chakri Award (PMCA)*, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Human Resource and Organizational Development (BHROD), hereby announces the **extension of the deadline for submission of nominations to the DepEd International Cooperation Office (ICO)**.

This PMCA recognizes active teachers or educational administrators who have made significant contributions to improving learners' lives and inspiring fellow educators. The nominees shall be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Participation in community and civic movements, particularly in areas where education is least accessible;
- Innovation in teaching practices that has benefited communities where the nominee has served;
- Ability to inspire and support the continuous development of learners and fellow teachers.

To allow sufficient time for regional-level evaluation and consolidation of documentary requirements, the deadline for the submission of regional nominees is hereby extended as follows:

- **Original Deadline:** May 30, 2026
- **Extended Deadline:** June 25, 2026

Submission Guidelines:

1. Interested applicants shall submit their documentary requirements to their respective Schools Division Offices (SDOs), including:
 - a. Updated Personal Data Sheet (CS Form 212);
 - b. A 1,500-word essay written by the applicant on why he/she should receive the Award;
 - c. Letter of Nomination from the SDO addressed to the Regional Director, duly signed and endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendent; and
 - d. Accomplished Matrix (Annex B) of relevant accomplishments with supporting documents.
(Note: Acronyms must be spelled out. Submission of training certificates are not required)
2. Regional Offices shall endorse the final nominee and transmit the complete requirements to ICO **on or before June 25, 2026 (Thursday)**.
