In line with the Philippine Statistics Authority's (PSA) unwavering commitment to digital transformation and ensuring that civil registration and vital statistics are accessible for all, the PSA officially launched the PSA E-Certificate Service on 25 February 2026.

The PSA E-Certificate Service, available through **psahelpine.ph**, offers fully digital and cryptographically secured versions of Birth, Marriage, and Death Certificates; Certificate of No Marriage (CENOMAR)/Advisory on Marriages; and Certificate of No Death (CENODEATH)/Advisory on Deaths. The PSA E-Certificate is the digital copy of the civil registry document or certification and is sent to the client via email through a secure access link.

To ensure integrity of the issued documents, the PSA E-Certificate can be validated by scanning the Quick Response (QR) Code displayed on the cover page of the E-Certificate or by accessing the verification portal at **e-cert.psahelpine.ph**.

Security, privacy, and authenticity of PSA-issued documents are prioritized to ensure the integrity, confidentiality, and reliability of all issued records. The PSA encourages all stakeholders to accept and utilize the PSA E-Certificate in transactions and integrate within their service processes for a more efficient, secure, and seamless experience.

PUBLIC ADVISORY

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) launched the PSA E-Certificate Service as part of its continuing push towards digital transformation and enhanced data privacy, security, and promoting convenient access to vital documents.

The PSA E-Certificate Service, available through psahelpline.ph offers fully digital and cryptographically secured versions of Birth, Marriage, and Death Certificates, Certificate of No Marriage (CENOMAR)/Advisory on Marriages, and Certificate of No Death (CENODEATH)/Advisory on Death.

The PSA E-Certificate is delivered via email through a secure access link and is the exact digital scanned copy of the physical document printed on security paper, provided in Portable Document Format (PDF). As such, it carries the same legal validity as the physical document issued by the PSA.

Moreover, to uphold the highest standards of integrity and ensure the authenticity of the vital record, stakeholders can verify the document by scanning the Quick Response (QR) Code displayed on the cover page of the e-certificate or by accessing the verification portal at e-cert.psahelpline.ph.

The PSA encourages the public to utilize the PSA E-Certificate Service for a more efficient and secure way of obtaining civil registry documents.

Additional Information on the Philippine Statistics Authority E-Certificate Service

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) E-Certificate Service offers fully digital and cryptographically secured versions of civil registry documents and certifications.

A. Application Process

1. **Application:** Visit the e-cert.psahelpine.ph, select the document needed, and fill out the order form.
2. **Payment:** Pay through any of the payment channels integrated with the service, through e-wallets, credit/debit cards, or online banking.
3. **Verification:** A mandatory Identity Verification Process ensures that sensitive data only reaches the rightful owner.
4. **Delivery:** The requesting party receives a secure link via email to view and download their PSA e-Certificate.
