**OBSERVANCE OF THE 2026 NATIONAL FLAG DAYS**

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 678, s. 2026 on the observance of the **2026 National Flag Days**, and in accordance with Presidential Proclamation No. 374, s. 1965 and Executive Order No. 179, s. 1994, all public elementary and secondary schools in the Schools Division of Vigan City are enjoined to actively participate in the observance from **May 28 to June 12, 2026**.

2. In support of this national celebration, schools are encouraged to undertake the following activities:

- a. Display the Philippine National Flag prominently in school offices, buildings, and other facilities;
- b. Post information on official school social media platforms regarding the celebration and its significance;
- c. Conduct the solemn burning of worn-out Philippine flags in accordance with existing protocols and regulations governing the proper disposal of national flags;
- d. Integrate lessons and discussions on the history and significance of the National Flag Days celebration in classroom instruction; and
- e. Participate in related activities initiated by the community and/or local government units.

**OBSERVANCE OF THE 2026 NATIONAL FLAG DAYS**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Adherent to Presidential Proclamation No. 374, s. 1965 declaring May 28 every year as the National Flag Day and Executive Order No. 179, s.1994, ordering the prominent display of the national flag from May 28 to June 12 every year, this Office announces the observance of the National Flag Days.

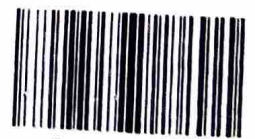
