RESUMPTION OF AUSTERITY MEASURES IN THE USE OF AIRCONDITIONING UNITS IN THE DIVISION OFFICE STARTING JUNE 9, 2026

To: ALL SDO Personnel

1. **OSDS MEMO 00-0422-001** established the SDO Vigan City Energy Efficiency and Conservation and other Austerity Measures on the use of office facilities.
2. On May 4, 2026 this office released **Office Memorandum No. 30, s. 2026** suspending the implementation schedule for turning-on and off of air-conditioning units due to the PAGASA report on extreme heat in Vigan City.
3. On June 4, 2026 **PAGASA has reported the onset of the rainy season** across the western sections of Luzon and Visayas. **However, periods of reduced rainfall, commonly referred to as monsoon breaks, may occur and last for several days or weeks.**
4. In line with these developments, all offices are instructed to **revert to the austerity practice of using air-conditioning units starting from 9:00 am and turning off at 4:00 pm.**
5. However, during monsoon breaks and when the heat index reaches 40°C or higher, air-conditioning units **may be operated from 8:00 a.m. onward** to ensure the safety and well-being of personnel.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

ONSET OF THE RAINY SEASON

Based on the weather observations and analyses, occasional to frequent rains associated with the Southwest Monsoon (*Habagat*) have been observed over the past five days. This signifies the onset of the rainy season across the western sections of Luzon and the Visayas.

However, periods of reduced rainfall, commonly referred to as monsoon breaks, may occur and last for several days or weeks.

Moreover, with the looming El Niño, enhanced *Habagat* rainfall over the western sections of Luzon and Visayas is highly likely during the season.

PAGASA will continue to monitor the weather and climate situation in the country. The public and all concerned agencies are advised to take precautionary measures against the adverse impacts of the rainy season, *Habagat*, and other climate and weather events.
