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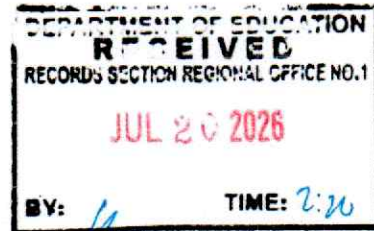

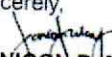

The session also examines publication ethics, common reasons for manuscript rejection, and practical approaches to strengthening research quality, originality, and scholarly writing. In addition, it highlights effective practices for increasing research visibility, citation potential, and academic impact through responsible publishing. Designed for both emerging and experienced researchers, this session equips participants with the knowledge and confidence to navigate the international publishing landscape and build a sustainable record of high-quality scholarly publications.
