MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement, hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement," is entered into this day of 07 MAY 2026 2026 at City of San Fernando, La Union, Philippines, by and between:

The **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION REGIONAL OFFICE 1**, a government entity mandated by the law to ensure the delivery of quality basic education, particularly under Batas Pambansa Blg. 232, otherwise known as the "Education Act of 1982," as amended by Republic Act No. 9155, otherwise known as the "Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001," with principal address at Don Flores St., Catbangan, City of San Fernando, La Union, represented herein by the Regional Director, **DR. ESTELA P. LEON-CARIÑO**, and hereinafter referred to as "**DepEd RI**"

-and-

The **CHINA BANK SAVINGS, INC.**, a domestic bank organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal address at A.G. Zambrano Building Quezon Avenue, City of San Fernando, La Union, represented herein by its APDLG Region 1 Region Head., **HYRIE-JEAREM C. OCON**, hereinafter referred to as "**CBS**":

Collectively being referred to as "**Parties**" and individually as a "**Party**."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 4(1) of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State recognizes the complementary roles of public and private institutions in the educational system and shall exercise reasonable supervision and regulation of all educational institutions;

WHEREAS, under Batas Pambansa Blg. 232, or the "Education Act of 1982," As amended by RA No. 9155, or the "Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001," DepEd is a government agency mandated to:

- a. Formulate, implement, and coordinate policies, plans, programs and projects in the areas of formal and non-formal basic education;
- b. Supervise all elementary and secondary education institutions, including alternative learning systems, both public and private; and
- c. Provide for the establishment and maintenance of a complete, adequate, and integrated system of basic education relevant to the goals of national development, while ensuring the well-being of its personnel and learners;

WHEREAS, DepEd RI, believes that partnership is an important paradigm in delivering and achieving DepEd's education development goals and services and to fulfill the mandate of the Constitution to make such quality education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, DepEd RI has the responsibility of securing resources to make the public schools competitive and is now calling on the private sector to serve as a major partner for the improvement of the public education system and in the nation's development;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8525 (RA 8525), otherwise known as the "Adopt-a-School Act of 1998," was enacted to encourage private entities to assist in the delivery of better-quality education to public schools in the country, particularly in the poverty-stricken provinces:

WHEREAS, Section 5 of RA 8525 provides that "(p)rovisions of existing laws to the contrary notwithstanding, expenses incurred by the adopting entity for the 'Adopt-A-School Program' shall be allowed an additional deduction from the gross income equivalent to fifty percent (50%) of such expenses.":

WHEREAS, the Department of Finance (DOF), through the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR), issued Revenue Regulations No. 10, s. 2003, entitled "Implementing Tax Incentives Provisions of Republic Act No. 8525, Otherwise Known as the 'Adopt-A-School Act of 1998'";

WHEREAS, DepEd R1, shall comply with the applicable rules on the valuation of contributions or donations of private partners to DepEd and the proper recording of the donated items categorized as Property, Plant, and Equipment as contained in Item VII of the enclosure to DepEd Order No. 24, s. 2016 entitled "Guidelines on Accepting Donations and on Processing Applications for the Availment of Tax Incentives by Private Donor-Partners Supporting the K to 12 Program," which provides the Valuation of Assistance/Contribution or Donation and the formula of computation for the value to be reflected in the Deed of Donation and the records of donated goods and services and DepEd Order No. 82, s. 2011 entitled "Guidelines on the Proper Recording of all Donated Properties";

WHEREAS, both Parties recognize and undertake to comply with Republic Act No. 10173, otherwise known as the "Data Privacy Act of 2012," its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and other related issuances of the National Privacy Commission (NPC) and "Freedom of Information Order under E.O. No. 2, s. 2016," for the implementation of this Agreement;

WHEREAS, CBS is a business enterprise engaged in Banking and Finance that has been a source of support to other community service and serve Filipino community in helping those in need;

WHEREAS, CBS support DepEd thrusts through the BEDP 2030 by supporting major programs such as *Brigada Eskwela* in preparation for the school opening nationwide. The program brings together parents, students, alumni, civic groups, local businesses, non-government organizations and individuals who volunteer their time and skills to do classroom repairs, maintenance work, and clean-up of public elementary and secondary schools.

WHEREAS, CBS is committed to support the DepEd in uplifting the quality basic education in the Philippines.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the terms and conditions herein set forth, the Parties agree as follows:

Article I. CBS' SPONSORSHIP AND ADVOCACIES IN EDUCATION

In support to the "Adopt-A-School Program" and DepEd's Implementation of Brigada Eskwela, CBS aims to accommodate more schools and learners nationwide by supporting the immediate need of the schools in time for the opening of classes for the School Year 2026-2027 and 2027-2028.

Article II. PROGRAM SCOPE AND BENEFICIARY

The program beneficiary shall be the selected public schools, learners and teachers within Region 01. The list of program beneficiaries shall be identified in coordination with DepEd based on priorities region wide.

Article III. PROGRAM COST

The estimated total cost of the Program is **One Million Ninety-Eight Thousand Pesos (Php 1,098,000.00)**. Please see Annex A for the breakdown per school.

The aforementioned cost is just an estimate and shall be subject to validation consistent with RA 8525 and other existing applicable laws, rules, and regulations on the valuation of donated items to educational institutions. DepEd shall not shoulder any cost or expenses in relation to this program.

Article IV. RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. DepEd R1 shall:

- 1.1 Provide policy guidance and directions to ensure the proper implementation of the Program;
- 1.2 Designate a focal person to serve as Partnership Coordinator for this Agreement;
- 1.3 Coordinate with CBS in the implementation and assist in the evaluation of the program;
- 1.4 Coordinate with CBS in the implementation of the program, including the acceptance of the package of assistance and execution of corresponding Deed of Acceptance through the Office of the Regional Director / Schools Division Superintendent and to determine specific division/ school beneficiaries.
- 1.5 Review and endorse the application for tax incentive entitlement to the Revenue District Office of the Bureau of Internal Revenue; and
- 1.6 Perform other responsibilities necessary for the effective and efficient implementation of the Program.

2. CBS shall:

- 2.1 Conceptualize the Project as part of its Corporate Social Responsibility program.
- 2.2 Designate a focal person to coordinate the implementation of this Agreement;
- 2.3 Provide funding in accordance with the provisions covering the project implementation of the Program;
- 2.4 Provide DepEd with regular reports, updates, as well as requested data and information relevant to the implementation of this Agreement;
- 2.5 Execute a Deed of Donation in favor of DepEd for the completed project and submit all pertinent documents in support to the amount specified/ claimed for tax incentive application;
- 2.6 Select and identify target areas/schools in close coordination with DepEd for the implementation of the Program;
- 2.7 Take the lead in the implementation of the Program under the guidance and supervision of DepEd;
- 2.8 Ensure that the documentary requirements for the availment of tax incentives are complete and in order; and
- 2.9 Perform other responsibilities necessary for the effective and efficient implementation of the Program.

Article V. TERM AND TERMINATION

1. This Agreement shall be valid immediately upon signing of the Parties. This Agreement shall have a duration of **two (2) years**, which shall commence on the date of signing of the Parties. This Agreement may however be extended upon mutual agreement of the Parties.
2. Any of the Parties may terminate this Agreement for reasonable grounds upon submission of a formal written notice to the other party at least 30 days before the intended date of termination.

Article VI. CAPACITY AND AUTHORIZATION

Each of the Parties to this Agreement hereby represents and warrants to the other that it is duly authorized and empowered to execute, deliver and perform this Agreement and that such

action does not conflict with or violate any provision of law, regulation, policy, contract, deed of trust or other instruments to which it is a party or by which it is bound and that this Agreement constitutes a valid and binding obligation of it enforceable in accordance with its terms.

Article VII. SEPARABILITY

In the event that any of the provisions of this Agreement or any document that may be executed in connection therewith shall be declared invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect by a competent authority, the validity, legality, and enforceability of the remaining provisions of this Agreement or any document that may be executed in connection therewith shall not in any way be affected or impaired and shall remain in full force and effect.

Article VIII. LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

The liability of the Parties for any breach of this Agreement shall be determined in accordance with applicable laws.

Article IX. SETTLEMENT OF DIFFERENCES

The Parties shall exert their best efforts to properly resolve any differences or disagreements with respect to any issue that may arise in connection with this Agreement. It shall be settled through amicable means, such as but not limited to, mutual consultation and negotiation.

Article X. AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may be amended or modified only in writing upon the consent of all the Parties or their duly authorized representative.

Article XI. DATA PRIVACY

The Parties shall comply with RA 10173, otherwise known as the "Data Privacy Act of 2012," its IRR and other relevant laws, rules and regulations on the matter in the event that personal information and/or sensitive personal information are used under this Agreement.

Article XII. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

1. All Parties shall comply with Republic Act No. 8293, otherwise known as the "Intellectual Property Code of the Philippines" and other applicable laws and rules governing intellectual property in the Philippines.
2. The Intellectual Property Rights to the outputs stated in this Agreement shall be owned by DepEd (the "Outputs"), unless otherwise provided in a supplemental agreement. For purposes of this provision, the Parties may specify such Outputs in a supplemental agreement, which shall be deemed part of this Agreement (the "Supplemental Agreement"). The CBS holds DepEd free and harmless from any and all liabilities arising from copyright infringement claims and/or any other intellectual property claims or suits from third parties for outputs to be agreed to be owned by CBS in the Supplementary Agreement. Attribution shall be given to the partner organization. }
Notwithstanding the foregoing, the claims of Intellectual Property Rights ownership by DepEd shall exclude all Intellectual Property Rights owned by CBS, including but not limited to any material actually owned by CBS that contains their logo(s).
3. Any use of a Party's knowledge products by the other Party, in relation to this Agreement, i.e., for academic and promotional materials, which include, but not limited to, logos, brochures, press releases, websites and other social media tools, shall be allowed upon prior written consent of the concerned Party and limited to the accomplishment of the objectives of this Agreement. }


Article XIV. MISCELLANEOUS


1. Except as otherwise provided herein, no Party shall have any right, power, or authority to create any obligation, express or implied, on behalf of any other Party. Nothing in this Agreement is intended to create or constitute a joint venture, partnerships, agency, trust, or other association of any kind between the Parties of persons referred to herein. The employees of each Party shall remain its employees and the concerned employer shall be solely responsible for the wages, benefits, and emoluments of such employees.
2. The Parties shall not assign or transfer this Agreement or any of the rights or obligations granted herein without the prior written consent of the other Party, and any purported assignment made without obtaining such written consent shall be null and void.
3. CBS is allowed, by way of press release/s thru traditional publication or via social media, to divulge this sponsorship and the activities indicated herein provided any press release would not put DepEd or its officials and employees in a bad light. The parties are allowed to announce and advertise their partnership, the contents of this agreement, and the result thereof, and the coverage of the activity.
4. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.
