Impact of Learning with Knowledge Channel Videos

Basa Bilang Year-End Report, 2022

Learners who learned with Wikaharian and Ready, Set, Read videos showed significant improvements in oracy, oral reading ability, and reading comprehension in Filipino and English respectively.

DLSU, National University, 2017

Students from schools which received the Knowledge Channel package performed better in achievement tests compared with comparison schools, as seen in mean percent achievement scores - 33% difference in the 2009 population, 31% in 2010, and 45% in 2011.

Lasallian Institute for Development and Educational Research, 2015

Researchers saw a 74.15% mean difference in scores with students in the Active learning environment which utilized the pause-play strategy with Knowledge Channel videos, compared with students in the Lecture - no Knowledge Channel video environment.
