DIVISION IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Public Elementary, Secondary and Integrated School Heads
School SBFP Focals, Alternates and TWGs
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 31, s. 2021, titled *Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program*; DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2017, titled *Policy and Guidelines on Healthy Food and Beverage Choices in Schools and DepEd Offices*; and relevant issuances from the Office of the Undersecretary for Operations, this Office announces the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for School Year 2026-2027.

2. The School-Based Feeding Program aims to improve the nutritional status, classroom attendance and academic performance of learners through the provision of nutritious meals and nutrition education interventions.

3. For School Year 2026-2027, the Schools Division of Vigan City shall implement the School-Based Feeding Program covering a total of One Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Five (1,385) beneficiaries, distributed as follows:

4. Elementary school learner beneficiaries shall include:
a. All enrolled Kindergarten learners;
b. All enrolled Grade 1 learners; and
c. Wasted and Severely Wasted learners from Grades 2 to 6 based on the validated Baseline Nutritional Status Report.

Secondary school learner beneficiaries & ALS shall include eligible learners belonging to highly marginalized and vulnerable groups, including but not limited to:

- a. Pregnant adolescent learners;
- b. Learner-mothers with children aged 0-1 year;
- c. Indigenous Peoples (IPs);
- d. Learners from indigent households including 4Ps beneficiaries;
- e. Out-of-school youth enrolled in Alternative Learning System (ALS) or Open

High School Program (OHSP); and
f. Other learners identified by the school as belonging to highly marginalized communities and requiring nutritional support.

5. For Elementary school learner beneficiaries, hot meals shall be provided **3 days per week** through the Central Kitchen Modality utilizing the Division-operated Central Kitchens located at:
 - a. Nagsangalan Elementary School Central Kitchen; and
 - b. Vigan Central School Central Kitchen
6. Feeding shall consist of a combination of Nutritious Food Products (NFPs), hot meals, and milk supplementation in accordance with approved program guidelines, menu cycles and prescribed nutritional standards.
7. **Elementary school learner beneficiaries** shall receive **feeding interventions for ninety-three (93) feeding days**, while qualified **secondary school/ALS learner beneficiaries** shall receive feeding interventions for **seventy eight (78) feeding days**. In addition, **milk supplementation** shall be provided for **thirty (30) feeding days**. (Please refer to the attached cycle menus, delivery schedules and central kitchen groupings).
8. To ensure the orderly implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for School Year 2026–2027, the feeding activities shall commence as follows:

Start of Feeding

Beyond Grade 6 Beneficiaries	July 13, 2026 (Monday)
Elementary Beneficiaries – Nutritious Food Products (NFP)	July 14, 2026 (Tuesday)
Elementary Beneficiaries – Hot Meals	July 21, 2026 (Tuesday)

9. School Heads shall:
 - a. ensure the accuracy and timely submission of beneficiary data and reports;
 - b. designate a School SBFP Focal and alternate;
 - c. facilitate beneficiary validation and monitoring activities;
 - d. ensure proper storage, handling and distribution of food commodities;
 - e. conduct regular monitoring of feeding implementation; and
 - f. ensure compliance with food safety and sanitation standards.
10. School SBFP Coordinators shall coordinate closely with the Division SBFP Focal Persons and School Health and Nutrition personnel to ensure the efficient and effective implementation of the program.

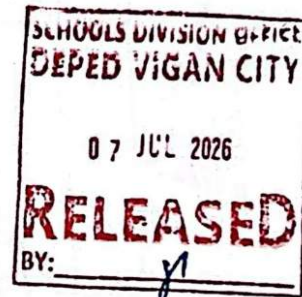

12. All concerned schools are directed to support and participate in all activities related to the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the School-Based Feeding Program.
13. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
