The UN Women's EmPower Academy will conduct a series of intensive online webinars on AI and Green Skills for Gender-Responsive Climate Action from 24 July to 12 August 2026 via an online platform.

The webinar series aims to provide young people with knowledge and practical skills on the use of artificial intelligence, climate action, entrepreneurship, and green skills in promoting inclusive, sustainable, and gender-responsive development.

The webinar series will cover the following topics: Introduction to Gender-Responsive AI (24 July 2026); AI for Climate Action (31 July 2026); Eco-preneurship Essentials (7 August 2026); and Graduation Day and Toolkit Demonstration (12 August 2026).

The webinar is free of charge. Interested participants who wish to attend more than one session are required to register separately for each webinar. The deadline for registration is 22 July 2026.

Target participants are young people aged 15-24 years across Asia and the Pacific, including learners from educational institutions, as well as members of youth networks, civil society organizations, and partner institutions. Participation shall be voluntary and, for DepEd learners, shall be subject to the approval of the school head and the consent of their parents or guardians, as applicable. Participation of learners shall not disrupt or adversely affect the prescribed instructional time or instructional block, in accordance with existing DepEd policies. Likewise, participation of interested DepEd personnel shall be voluntary and subject to office exigencies and the approval of their respective heads of office.

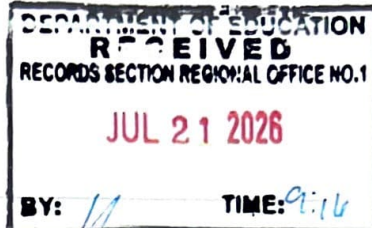

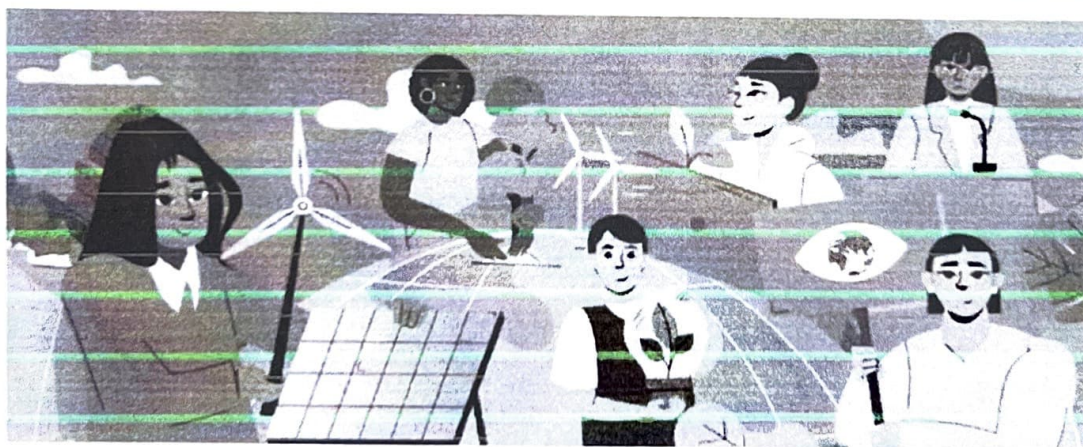
