SUBJECT: ROVER SCOUT ORIENTATION, VIGIL, AND INVESTITURE

1. Rover Scouting is the final and most dynamic phase in the Scouting Movement, designed for young people aged 16 to 24. It focuses on leadership, community involvement, self-development, and preparing the youth to become active citizens and future leaders. Rooted in service and personal challenge, Rover Scouting offers unique opportunities for adventure, growth, and brotherhood among young men and women.
2. In line with the Vision of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines—engaging three million people to become proactive contributors to their communities—the Ilocos Sur Council will conduct a Rover Scout Orientation, Vigil, and Investiture Ceremony to strengthen Rover Scouting in the province.
