5. A registration fee of P7,800.00 per participant shall be collected to cover meals, training kits, venue, accommodation and honorarium of speakers. The registration fee, travel expenses, and other related expenses may be charged against MOOE/local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

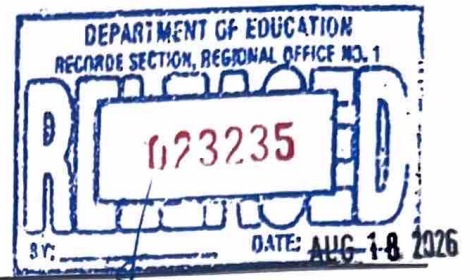
