The activity will showcase the unique products, skills, creativity, and cultural heritage of our local communities, highlighting the important contribution of our barangays to tourism and local economic development.

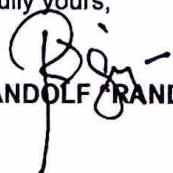
